Overview

Set in a peaceful hamlet just 5km from Cortona, Villa Scotoni is a warm, welcoming retreat for 8–10 guests, ideal for families or friends traveling together.

Built from local stone with terracotta roof tiles, this traditional Tuscan farmhouse retains its authentic charm with original floors, beams, fireplaces, and antique furnishings, while offering modern comforts. Each floor has its own kitchen, creating a flexible layout that works like separate apartments—ideal for shared holidays with private space.

The main floor features a fully equipped kitchen and a large dining room perfect for gathering, while the upper floors provide additional living areas with cozy sofas and fireplaces. There are four double bedrooms, plus two optional singles, and four bathrooms, all spacious and garden-facing.

Outside, the tiered garden offers lovely views of the surrounding valley, shaded by mature trees and filled with climbing plants. The fenced private pool is perfect for relaxing or playing, and multiple outdoor dining areas invite you to enjoy al fresco meals under the Tuscan sun.

Though surrounded by countryside, you're only minutes from Cortona, known for its history and views, and Camucia, offering shops and amenities. Day trips to Lake Trasimeno, Arezzo, and Perugia make Villa Scotoni an ideal base to explore Tuscany and Umbria while enjoying the peace of a rural retreat.

Location & Local Information

Perched in a hillside hamlet in the heart of rural Tuscany, Villa Scotoni offers an ideal base for exploring local villages and enjoying outdoor activities. With shops and dining options nearby, guests can also visit organic farms, vineyards, and the stunning Castello di Montecchio Vesponi, perfect for a scenic countryside walk. Nearby farms offer horse treks and Italian cookery classes, making it a great choice for families and groups.

Just 5km away, the historic hilltop town of Cortona invites visitors to wander its medieval streets, discover its Etruscan origins, and admire views over the Val di Chiana. Notable sights include Palazzo Casali, the Fortress del Girifalco, and exhibitions at the Diocesano Art Museum.

For a more vibrant city atmosphere, Arezzo (23km) offers a rich mix of culture and history. Once a vital trade route, it's home to a Medici fortress, the Basilica of Saint Francis with frescoes by Piero della Francesca, and the National Museum of Medieval and Modern Art. Explore its winding streets filled with cafés, markets, and historic landmarks.

For a full-day adventure, the medieval city of Siena, just 78km away, offers art, architecture, and the spectacular Duomo, making it a must-visit during your Tuscan stay.
