Location & Local Information

Located just outside a small village in the French Riviera, a mere 19km west of Saint-Tropez and 50km east of Toulon, La Vue Des Maures is perched at the level of two valleys in the Massif des Maures mountain range.

Surrounded by rolling hills, vineyards, and olive groves, this picturesque village is a quiet retreat from the bustling nearby coastline. Stroll the village's cobblestone streets amidst charming rustic architecture for an authentic experience of Provençal beauty and lifestyle.

The Massif des Maures mountain range itself offers a wealth of verdant landscapes for the nature enthusiast. If you can drag yourself away from nearby vineyards and wineries, the area offers great opportunities for scenic hiking.

In the nearby town of Cogolin (9km) can be found a wide range of shops and restaurants. The area also boasts easy access to seaside resorts including the family-focused Cavalaire-sur-Mer, which is particularly renowned for its water sports including jet skiing, sailing, windsurfing, and scuba diving.

The village of Gassin (20 minutes) is perched high on a rocky outcrop commanding unbeatable views of the Bay of Saint-Tropez and coastline. Gassin is commonly classified among the most beautiful villages in France.

Of course, no visit to the region would be complete without a glimpse of Saint Tropez itself, the glamourous and historic village is one of the jewels in the crown of the French Mediterranean, and less than thirty minutes from La Vue Des Maures by car.

Escape to La Vue Des Maures and let time slow down to a more pleasant pace. Settle into the villa's enchanting outdoor areas or embark on short day trips to the litany of nearby attractions basking in the southern sun.
