Location & Local Information

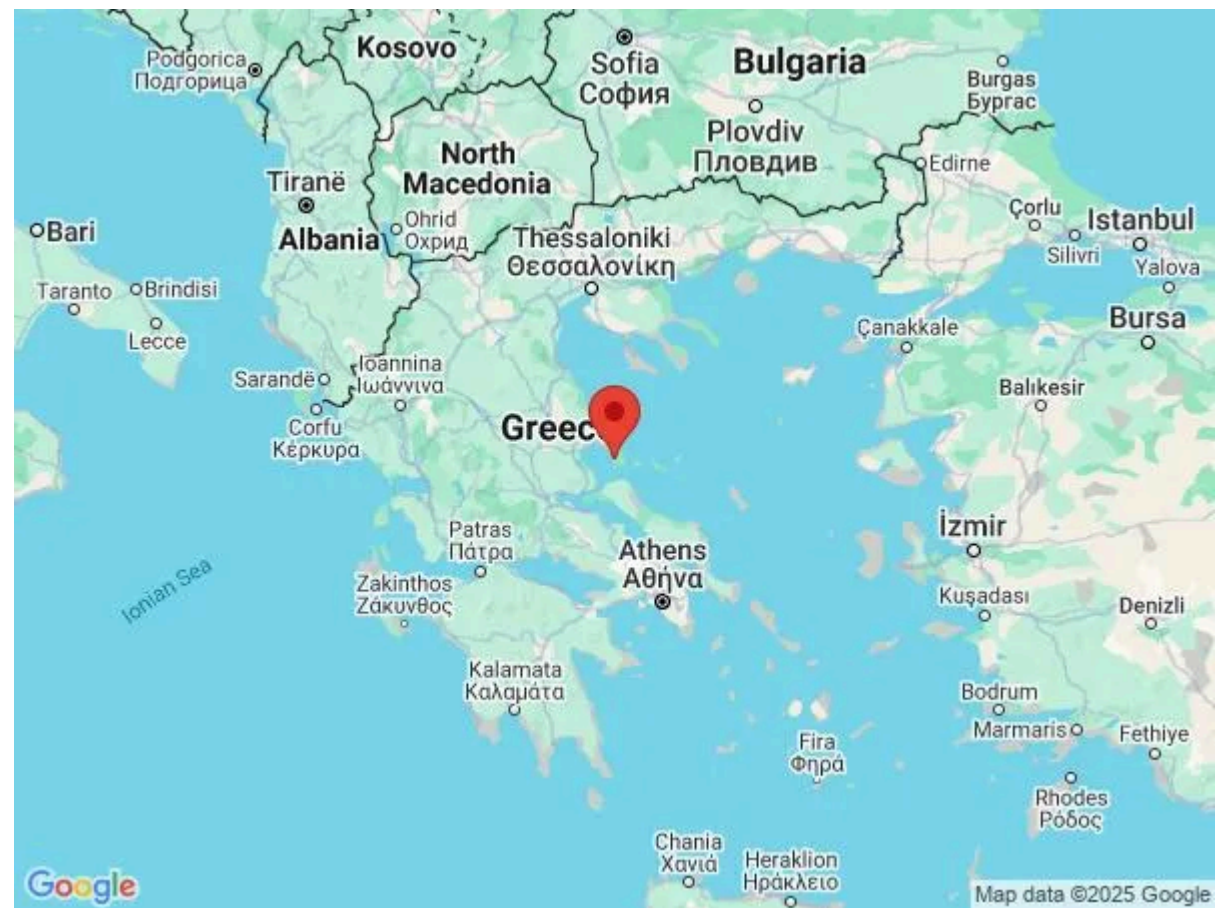
