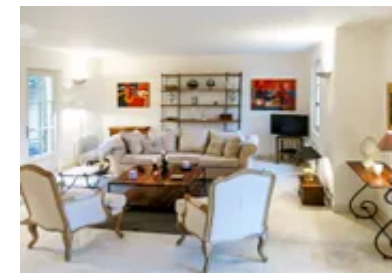
The ground floor also hosts three of the bedrooms, one of which features a double while the further two rooms house twin beds, ideal for families or groups. A bathroom with shower, along with two separate WCs, completes the floor. Upstairs is another tastefully furnished bedroom with a luxurious double bed, as well as the second bathroom and a separate WC.

Within the fenced grounds of Maison Maussane, the refreshing swimming pool beckons for leisurely dips, surrounded by a pergola and terrace where al fresco dining and lounging await. With a portable barbecue and deck chairs at your disposal, the outdoor area invites you to relax amidst the well-kept foliage.

Situated just a short walk from the centre of a Provençal village, this lovely home is in close proximity to a number of shops and dining options, allowing you to feel like one of the locals. 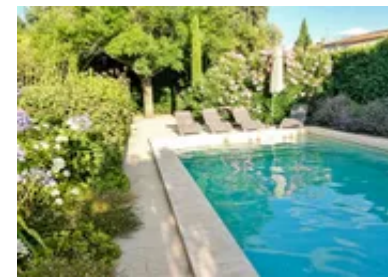

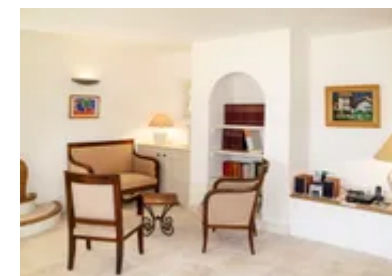
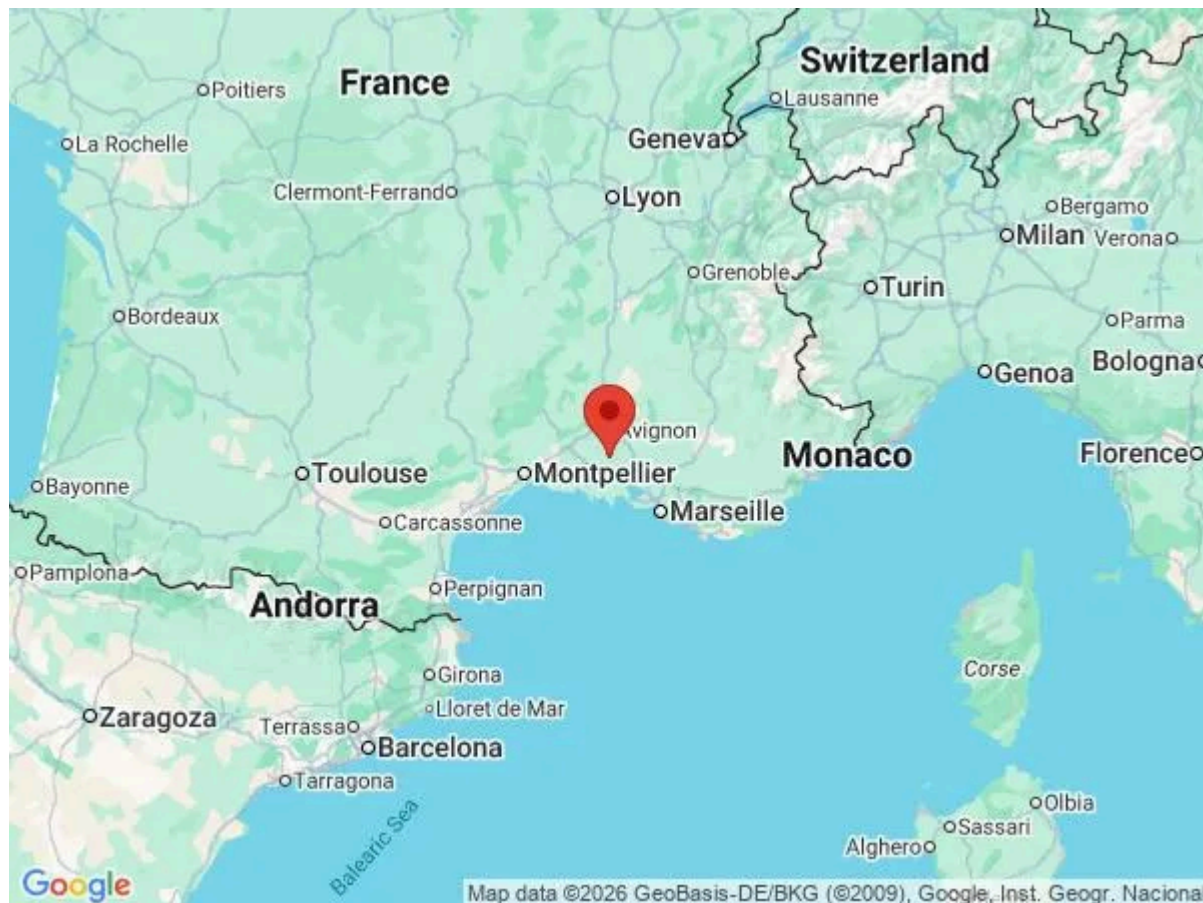
