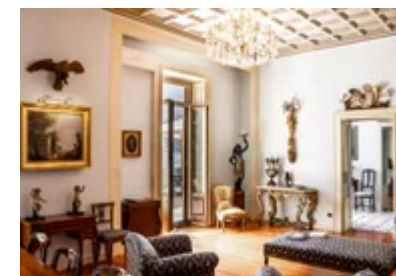

- The villa has direct lake access and guests can reach the nearest restaurants and village centre on foot, making this a great base for your Lake Como escape.

What you should know...

- The garden offers a lovely new pool, parents should know that this is not fenced.
- The studio room with a single bed on the first floor is available on request and incurs an additional charge or you can request additional beds for children to add to your own room as long as the house is not over capacity.
- At the villa there is a storage area with wine, champagne and beer available to purchase.
- In order to keep the jacuzzi warm and clean we ask that you cover it after use.
- A car is recommended to explore the local area. The private parking is located behind the villa, you will need to cross the road or use the private tunnel with several steps.
- Please note that the use of any external caterers and/or contractors is not permitted.
- Please note the pool can be heated on request by a heat pump that is reliant on outside temperatures and can be heated to a maximum of 26 degrees.

- **Security deposit:** €2000 paid in cash to the owner upon arrival and refunded upon departure, subject to full inspection.
- **Arrival time:** 4.30 p.m. to 7.00 p.m. Check-in outside this time may be subject to an extra cost. Please enquire for more details.
- **Departure time:** Before 9.30 a.m.
- **Energy costs included?:** Yes, up to €100 per week. Excess charged upon consumption (including air-conditioning).
- **Linen & towels included?:** Yes. Pool towels included too.
- **Pets welcome?:** Not allowed.
- **Other Ts and Cs:** Please note that your booking will only be confirmed once we have checked availability with the owner. An extra bed is available upon request, for extra €300 per week payable locally in cash. A cot is available upon request, for extra €100 per week payable locally in cash. Please note that the use of any external caterers and/or contractors is not permitted.
- **Changeover day:** Saturday.
- **End of stay cleaning available?:** Yes. However, guests are required to leave the accommodation clean, tidy and in the same condition as on their arrival. Any extra cleaning, laundry, maintenance and/or rubbish disposal required will be charged against the security deposit.
- **Smoking Allowed?:** Not allowed.
- **Minimum stay:** 7 nights. All other durations are on request.
- **Heating costs included?:** Yes, up to €50 per week. Excess charged upon consumption.
- **Pool heating charge?:** The pool and Jacuzzi can be heated on request at an extra cost of €200 per week each, payable locally in cash. Please note the pool is heated by a heat pump that is reliant on outside temperatures and can be heated to a maximum of 26 degrees. Please note that like all heated pools, pool heating and water temperature are reliant on weather and outside temperatures.
- **Tax:** Italian Visitors Tax payable locally in cash (typically costs €1-€10 per adult per night - please enquire if exact amount is required).
- **Internet access?:** Wi-Fi internet access included.
- **Pool opening dates?:** The pool is open approximately May to late September. Please note that pool opening dates are subject to local weather conditions and pool maintenance requirements and that cooler months may not be suitable for swimming.
