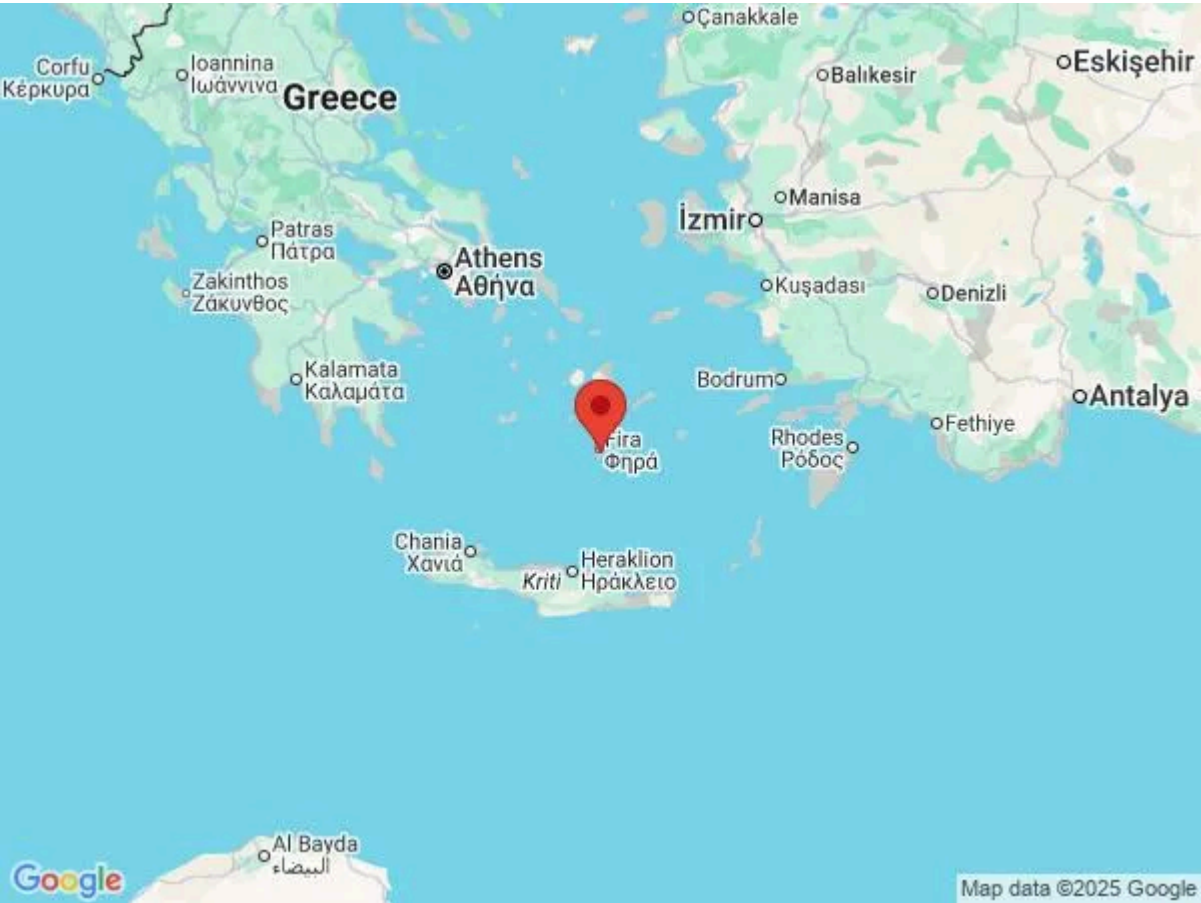

- Santa Croce is an historical villa reconstructed in compliance with traditional architectural standards; consequently, some areas may not be in conformity with contemporary security specifications (e.g. the height of some outside walls is 60 cm).
- Children of all ages are welcome under the responsibility of their parents. The pool and the jacuzzi are not child-protected areas. Babysitting services can be arranged upon request.

- **Security deposit:** €1000 charged to client's credit card before arrival and refunded two weeks after departure, subject to full inspection.
- **Arrival time:** 14.00
