Overview

Rosalinda, located in the heart of the Luberon, is a beautifully restored old stone mill, surrounded by stunning Provençal landscapes, just a stone's throw away from the historic towns of Gordes and Fontaine-de-Vaucluse. Explore the nearby vineyards, lavender fields, and local markets to really take in the beauty of the French countryside.

Set amidst an expansive park and flourishing orchard, this historic property is surrounded by sprawling greenery. A fountain and quaint canal can be found at the rear, while the main house connects to a delightful terrace, leading to a mazet with a summer kitchen, opening on to the terrace and private pool just beyond. Inside, the home is bright and spacious with tasteful modern furnishings, sleeping up to 9 guests across four bedrooms.

Despite Rosalinda's rural location, the nearby hamlet of Lagnes can be reached in just a few minutes by car, or a 20-minute walk along the road (no pavement). Lagnes is a beautiful Provençal village, featuring cobblestone streets, a historic château, local markets, and a variety of cafes and restaurants.

Just a 15-minute drive away is Gordes, recognised as one of the most beautiful villages in France, it is perched on the foothills of the Monts de Vaucluse with stunning views over the Luberon. The local area offers an array of family-friendly activities amid the breathtaking Luberon landscapes, including hiking, cycling, horse-riding, and rock climbing. Be sure to visit other enchanting villages like Lacoste, Ménerbes, and Bonnieux, or venture to the picturesque Les Alpilles near Arles. For a cultural day trip, the historic cities of Avignon and Aix-en-Provence can be reached within 40-60 minutes.

Location & Local Information

Rosalinda is well located in the Vaucluse department of Provence, surrounded by stunning vineyards, groves and lavender fields. Just a few minutes' drive away is the village of Lagnes, featuring a charming selection of restaurants, cafés, and a bakery for the morning pastry run.

For more comprehensive shopping and dining, head to nearby L'Isle-sur-la-Sorgue, known as the "Venice of the North" with its scenic canals, historic water wheels, and bustling weekend markets, including the renowned Sunday *brocante*.

A short 15-minute drive brings you to Gordes, one of France's most beautiful villages, perched on the Monts de Vaucluse and offering stunning views over the Luberon. Don't miss the fragrant lavender fields of Sénanque Abbey nearby before exploring further into the Luberon to Apt, celebrated for its fine local produce and vibrant markets. The nearby villages of Ménerbes and Bonnieux also host delightful eateries and quaint streets.

For outdoor enthusiasts, the Luberon National Park offers excellent hiking and biking trails, while the nearby, and very picturesque, Golf de Saumane provides a scenic round of golf. Enjoy canoeing on the River Sorgue or tour the region's renowned vineyards and wineries.

Venture a bit further to explore Les Alpilles and the artistic town of Saint-Rémy-de-Provence. For a deeper dive into Provence's rich history and culture, Avignon's UNESCO World Heritage sites and Aix-en-Provence, known for its university and vibrant arts scene, are both worth a visit. Known as the "City of Popes", Avignon is home to the majestic *Palais des Papes*, one of the largest and most important medieval Gothic buildings in Europe. Aix-en-Provence is known for its stunning architecture, tree-lined boulevards, and bustling markets. Visit the Cours Mirabeau, a beautiful avenue shaded by plane trees, and explore the city's many art galleries and museums, including the Atelier Cézanne, where the famous painter Paul Cézanne once worked. Arles, gateway to the Camargue, is also just over an hour away, perfect for an extended day trip.
