Overview

Villa Artie sits on Croatia's Pelješac peninsula, offering uninterrupted views across the Adriatic and a calm, well-considered setting for a coastal stay. Designed with simplicity and comfort in mind, it suits families or small groups looking for space, privacy, and easy access to the region's beaches and wineries.

The interiors are centred around an open-plan living area, where the kitchen, dining space, and lounge flow together with plenty of natural light. Three en-suite bedrooms provide a comfortable and private setup for guests, each finished in a modern, understated style.

Outside, the terrace and private pool make the most of the sea-facing position. Days here are easily spent between swimming, reading in the sun, and long, relaxed meals outdoors, with the changing light over the water as a constant backdrop.

The nearby village of Trstenik is just a short drive away, offering a selection of restaurants, beaches, and local amenities. Villa Artie works equally well as a base for exploring the peninsula or simply settling into a slower pace by the coast.

- **Security deposit:** €500 paid in cash to the owner upon arrival and refunded upon departure, subject to full inspection.
