Hippocampe

Region: Normandy Sleeps: 6

Overview

Once the stables of a 17th century *manoir*, Hippocampe is a wonderful holiday home on the Cotentin peninsula just a short cycle ride from the beach and close to several important WWII sites in Normandy.

Step into the warm and cosy living space with traditionally tiled flooring, comfortable seating, a rustic dining table and an open-plan modern kitchen. There is an authentically charming ambience throughout with many nods to the past with its horse themed décor. French windows open out to a pretty terrace area for al-fresco meals accompanied by the sounds of church bells and bleating sheep.

Follow the sensitively designed staircase to the upper floor for three lovely bedrooms including an especially romantic double with a canopied bed, lofty ceilings and a bath tub alongside two further en suite bedrooms (one double, one double or twin). With elegant interiors, Hippocampe comfortably sleeps up to 6 guests.

This inviting home is located in the south-wing of Manoir Cotentin (https://www.oliverstravels.com/france/normandy/manoir-cotentin/) and also part of the same beautiful estate as neighbouring La Marine (https://www.oliverstravels.com/france/normandy/la-marine/) and the old pigeonnier, Le Cormoran

(https://www.oliverstravels.com/france/normandy/le-cormoran/). Whilst the former stables has its own terrace area, the vast grounds are otherwise shared between all four dwellings – stroll around the old château ruins, admire summer lavender and roses, seek solitude by the pond and relax across the English and French-style gardens.

The old church regularly chimes its bells next door and just a little further there is a small village. Make the most of the estate's bikes and cycle to the beach, just 3.5km away, to paddle or swim in the waves of the English channel at high tide. It's a lovely spot with colourful beach houses facing the

Across this stretch of coastline, discover summer horse-riding on the beach, sand-yachting in Utah, golf with a sea view and a wealth of WWII memorials and sites. Utah Beach and its Landing Museum is only 10km by car whilst Plage de Quinéville's World War II Museum is also within a short drive. Slightly inland, Sainte-Mère-Église, the first village to be liberated by Allied forces, is just over 7km away.

Enjoy a wealth of Normandy experiences. Try local oysters overlooking the marina in Saint-Vaast-la-Hougue or freshly harvested mussels in Barfleur, both picturesque coastal villages nearby. A little further afield, soak up the summer ambience of Barneville-Carteret, take a boat trip from Granville or even venture as far as Mont Saint-Michel, one of the most visited destinations in France.

Location & Local Information

Part of a historic estate, Hippocampe is located on the Cotentin peninsula around a 40-minute drive from Cherbourg ferry terminal. This *domaine* is also home to Manoir Cotentin

(https://www.oliverstravels.com/france/normandy/manoir-cotentin/), Le Cormoran (https://www.oliverstravels.com/france/normandy/le-cormoran/) and La Marine (https://www.oliverstravels.com/france/normandy/la-marine/) – all four dwellings share the beautiful grounds.

There is a village a short walk away with a restaurant, shop and another restaurant on the other side of the village (as always, seasonal opening dates of local restaurants can vary). Even closer, right next to the estate, is a traditional church with bells ringing from 7.00 a.m. to 10.00 p.m. (and every half hour in between for a shorter time).

Make the most of the estate's bikes or drive to the beach, only 3.5km away passing farmland and waterways en route. In the summer look out for a kiosk that is sometimes set up selling fresh oysters overlooking the sea and there is a French restaurant. The coast seems endless, especially at low tide, but when the tide comes in it's fun to paddle or even swim in the waves of the English channel. There's a little playground by the beach and colourful beach houses, adding to the overall charm.

This area is home to many war memorials and important WWII sites across the coast and countryside. Plage de Quinéville and the World War II Museum is just 9km away whilst Utah Beach and its fascinating museum is around a 10-minute drive heading south. The village of Sainte-Mère-Église (6.5km) is also nearby, one of the first villages to be liberated in 1944. Sainte-Mère-Église hosts a pretty market on a Thursday morning – food-lovers would also appreciate a trip to the Biscuiterie de Sainte-Mère-Église.

Drive to Saint-Vaast-la-Hougue (20km) for fresh oysters in one of the restaurants overlooking the marina. There's two Vauban Towers near here, both UNESCO World Heritage sites, one on the mainland just south of Saint-Vaast-la-Hougue and one on Tatihou Island reached via an amphibious boat which travels across the oyster beds at low tide. Barfleur (27km) is another picture-perfect spot for lunch, famed for its *moules-frites* using freshly harvested mussels from the English channel (when in season).

The maritime city of Cherbourg (48km) is an interesting day out or venture to the western side of the peninsula to spend time in Barneville-Carteret (44km) or Granville (85km). Historic Bayeux (62km) could perhaps be combined with other iconic D-Day Landing beaches such as Omaha (52km) and Arromanches-les-Bains (71km) or travel further afield to Mont Saint-Michel (141km), a remarkable sight and one of France's most visited loved destinations.
