Location & Local Information

Maison D'Or is located in a private *domaine* only a 10-minute drive to Saint-Tropez.

You can walk to a beautiful sandy beach and summer beachside restaurant in around 600m. This idyllic bay is much-loved thanks to its turquoise waters and sandy shores, backed by wetlands popular with birdwatchers.

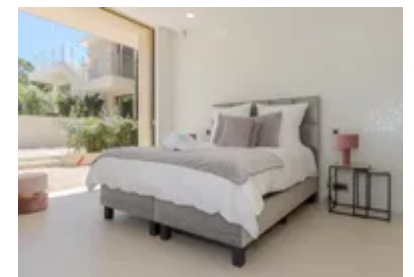
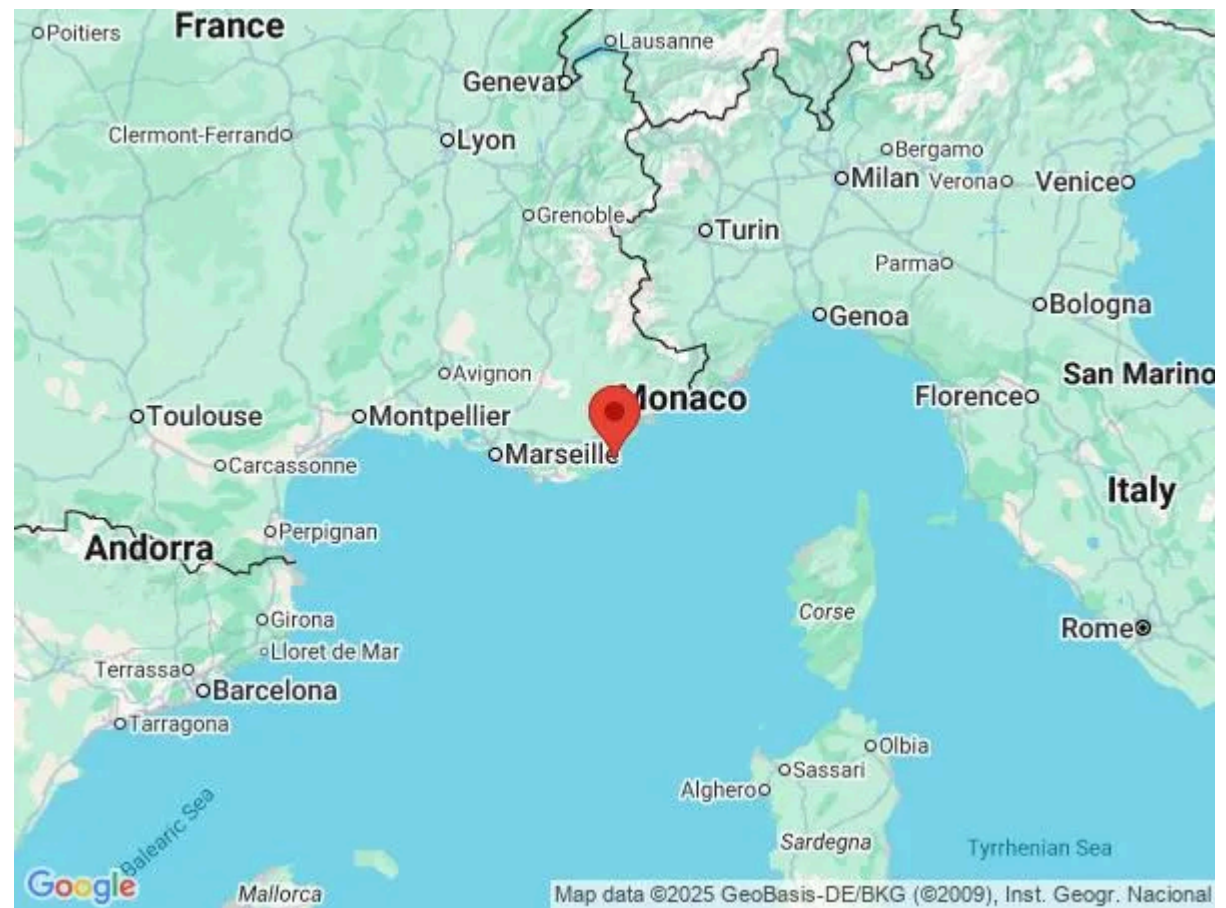
A little further afield by car, discover the 5km long stretch of coastline and one of France's most famous beaches, Plage de Pampelonne (8km), with fantastic range of water-based activities and exclusive beach clubs including the iconic Club 55 and Nikki Beach.

Beyond the beach, the surrounding region beckons with its quintessential Mediterranean charm. Saint-Tropez (4.5km), renowned for its glamour and allure, offers an intoxicating blend of luxury and tradition. Wander through the cobbled streets of the old town, where chic boutiques and art galleries sit alongside historic landmarks like the Citadel of Saint-Tropez, which boasts panoramic views over the bay. As evening falls, the lively harbour comes alive with an array of world-class restaurants and bars, perfect for savouring fine dining and good wines.

A short journey away from Saint-Tropez reveals a tapestry of picturesque villages, vineyards and rolling hills. Discover the enchanting village of Ramatuelle (14km), perched on a hillside and surrounded by fragrant pine forests. Its charming squares and quaint cafés offer a taste of authentic Provençal life.

Nearby, Gassin (13km), one of France's most beautiful villages, provides breathtaking views of the Gulf of Saint-Tropez from its elevated position. Here, you can immerse yourself in the region's viticulture with a visit to a local vineyard, sampling some of the finest rosé wines that the region has to offer.

For those seeking adventure, the area's natural beauty provides ample opportunities for walking, hiking, cycling, biking and horse-riding. Embark on a scenic hike along the



Sentier du Littoral, a coastal path offering dramatic vistas of rugged cliffs and secluded coves. Or, set sail from Saint-Tropez's marina to explore the azure waters and hidden gems of the Mediterranean.
