Spanning 450m2, this enchanting retreat offers spacious accommodation for up to 16 guests, making it an ideal choice for family gatherings or holiday with friends. Across the main farmhouse and its duplex annexe, the *mas* features seven individually appointed bedrooms, all with air-conditioning and many with their own bath or shower rooms. The expansive living and dining area is adorned with traditional Provençal features, creating a warm and inviting atmosphere – the original fireplace by the dining table is especially impressive.

Outside, the characterful courtyard is ideal for a coffee beneath the mulberry tree or take a stroll through the wild garden with herbs, oak trees and flowers. The highlight of the outdoor space is undoubtedly the large swimming pool, which can be heated on request, offering a refreshing respite during warm summer days. As evening appears, gather for al-fresco feasts on the covered terrace by the plancha-barbecue.

The farmhouse's proximity to Ménerbes allows for easy exploration of local attractions, including charming cafes, renowned vineyards, and scenic hiking trails. Whether you're looking to immerse yourself in the rich cultural heritage of the region or simply unwind in a traditional setting, Mas Josephine provides an unforgettable Provençal experience.

Location & Local Information


Set in a one-hectare plot with glorious Luberon vistas, Mas Josephine enjoys a rural setting on a country lane with a small handful of neighbours, only 2km from the famous perched village of Ménerbes.

Picturesque Ménerbes invites you to discover its timeless charm and unparalleled beauty. Perched atop a hill, Ménerbes is officially classified as one of France's most beautiful villages, offering breathtaking views of vineyards, cherry orchards and the Luberon Valley below. From its cobblestone streets to its ancient stone houses bathed in golden sunlight, Ménerbes exudes a tranquillity that makes it the perfect retreat for those seeking to experience the quintessential Provençal lifestyle.

Ménerbes is a treasure trove of history and culture. Stroll through its winding streets and discover architectural gems such as the 12th-century citadel, which stands as a testament to the village's rich past. Art enthusiasts will delight in the Maison de la Truffe et du Vin, where the region's famous truffles and wines take centre stage in a celebration of local flavours and traditions. For those with a penchant for art, the village has long been a haven for creatives, including renowned artists like Nicolas de Staël, whose spirit continues to inspire visitors.

Beyond Ménerbes, the surrounding Luberon region offers a wealth of attractions. Just a short drive away, you'll find the lavender fields of Sénanque Abbey (16km), a vision of purple perfection during the summer months. Explore the ochre cliffs of Roussillon (14.5km), or lose yourself in the Tuesday morning market of Gordes (13km), where fresh produce, handmade crafts and Provençal textiles await.

The Luberon's rolling vineyards and olive groves provide the perfect backdrop for scenic hikes or leisurely bike rides, allowing you to connect with nature and savour the region's serene pace of life. Just on the edge of the region, discover canoeing and kayaking along the Sorgue near Fontaine-de-Vaucluse or the Durance south of Lourmarin.









A little further afield, other wonderful days out include Avignon (38km) with its UNESCO World Heritage sites, the antique stores and Sunday morning brocante of L'Isle-surla-Sorgue (18km) and the art galleries of Saint-Rémy (42km) across this magical corner of Provence.

- There is also a sofa-bed for the sixteenth guest.
- It's a lovely house for families just be aware that it dates back to the 17th century so there are lots of stone steps and historic detailing.

- Security deposit: €5000 charged to client's credit card as a pre-authorisation at least 2 weeks prior to arrival and refunded two weeks after departure, subject to full inspection.
- Arrival time: 5.00 p.m.
- Departure time: 10.00 a.m.
