Outside, the landscaped garden enchants with its vibrant blooms and olive trees, while the heated pool beckons for refreshing dips. A pool house and summer kitchen make al-fresco dining and relaxation effortless.

Surround yourself with the beauty of the Luberon as you explore nearby villages and stunning landscapes. Start off in Ménerbes, an enchanting village steeped in history and surrounded by breathtaking scenery. Perched atop a hill, it offers panoramic views of the Luberon Valley, with its vineyards, olive groves, and orchards. Explore cobblestone streets, ancient stone houses and don't miss the Thursday morning market.







Nearby, visit renowned wineries, hike or cycle through incredible countryside and discover other picturesque villages like Gordes and Roussillon. The Luberon is perfect for savouring authentic Provençal cuisine, immersing yourself in art and culture, and experiencing the tranquil beauty of southern France.

Location & Local Information

With gorgeous views of the perched village of Ménerbes, one of France's 'Plus Beaux Villages', Maison Catellet enjoys a great location for exploring the Luberon and beyond. The house and its gardens is set on a country road in a hamlet with other neighbouring houses, businesses and farmland. The heart of Ménerbes is only 1.5km away (uphill).

Indeed, enchanting Ménerbes invites you to experience the timeless allure of the Luberon region. Perched on a hilltop, Ménerbes is a treasure trove of cobbled streets, historic stone houses, and panoramic views of lavender fields and vineyards stretching to the horizon. Known as one of the "Most Beautiful Villages of France", this serene retreat offers a perfect blend of cultural heritage and natural splendour. Wander through its narrow lanes to discover charming cafés, restaurants and a lovely Thursday morning market. History enthusiasts will delight in visiting the 16th-century citadel and the Maison de la Truffe et du Vin, which celebrates the region's gastronomic treasures.

Beyond Ménerbes, the Luberon region unfolds as a tapestry of picturesque landscapes and captivating experiences. Explore the ochre cliffs of Roussillon (15km), where vibrant red and gold hues contrast dramatically with the lush greenery. The nearby village of Gordes (13km), with its honey-coloured stone buildings cascading down the hillside, offers stunning views and an authentic Provençal market.

Nature lovers can venture into the Luberon Regional Natural Park, a haven of walking and cycling trails that wind through forests, fields, and charming hamlets. Don't miss the Abbaye de Sénanque (16km), a working monastery surrounded by fragrant lavender fields, offering a serene escape and a glimpse into monastic life.

Experience the wonderful Saturday morning market in Apt (20km), the largest in the region, or venture beyond the Luberon to L'Isle-sur-la-Sorgue (18km) for antique stores









and riverside restaurants or Fontaine-de-Vaucluse (17.5km) for canoeing and kayaking along the Sorgue River. Not forgetting the UNESCO World Heritage sites of Avignon (38km), the small and historic city by the banks of the Rhône.
