Maison Mayfly is located in Fontvieille, a charming village in the heart of Provence. This idyllic setting offers visitors a quintessential Provençal experience, with its scenic landscapes, historic landmarks, and vibrant local culture.

Fontvieille is known for its connections to French author Alphonse Daudet, whose famous windmill is a must-visit. The village also serves as a gateway to the Alpilles Natural Regional Park, where hiking and cycling trails wind through olive groves, vineyards, and limestone hills. Nearby, the ancient Roman aqueduct and mill of Barbegal provide a fascinating glimpse into the area's rich history.

For food enthusiasts, Provence's culinary delights await. Savor local delicacies such as ratatouille, tapenade, and a variety of goat cheeses, best paired with regional wines. Weekly markets in Fontvieille and nearby towns like Arles and Saint-Rémy-de-Provence offer a chance to immerse yourself in local traditions while picking up fresh produce and artisanal goods.

Cultural highlights include exploring the UNESCO-listed Roman ruins in Arles, less than 10 kilometers away, and visiting the picturesque villages of Les Baux-de-Provence and Eygalières.
