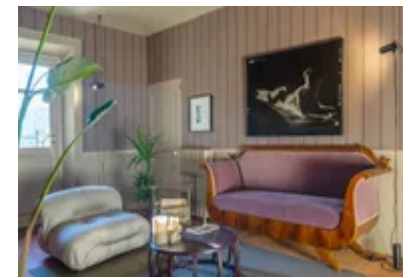

Location & Local Information

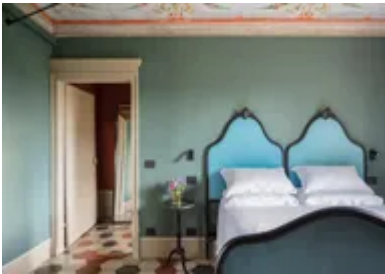
