Overview

Amidst the glorious countryside just north of Eygalières, this charmingly restored 18th-century farmhouse offers a traditional Provençal experience. Surrounded by three hectares of unspoiled nature, this haven invites you to savour the slow pace of life, whether you're strolling beneath ancient trees, soaking up the sun by the pool, or enjoying a game of pétanque on the rustic grounds.

Inside, the farmhouse spans an impressive 400m², combining character with modern comfort. On the ground floor, a spacious and light-filled living area welcomes you with contemporary furnishings whilst the kitchen, equipped for culinary adventures, opens onto a shaded terrace ideal for al fresco dining. Five attractive bedrooms, each with its own unique character, provide space for relaxation and privacy across both floors, and there are four bathrooms (two en suite).

Step outside and discover a world of leisure alongside wild gardens, summer flowers, herbs and a little brook. The sparkling 18m-long swimming pool is a highlight, complete with a shallow paddling area for children. A nearby terrace offers the perfect spot for refreshments, while the surrounding field invites spirited outdoor games in a serene setting.

Half an hour south of Avignon, the authentic environment feels delightfully rural yet is only 2km from the beautiful village of Eygalières, known for its timeless charm, upmarket restaurants and Friday morning market. You are also well located for reaching artistic Saint-Rémy-de-Provence, just a 15-minute drive away.

Whether you're drawn by the allure of the Alpilles or the promise of unforgettable gatherings in a rustic setting, this







historic farmhouse promises an enchanting Provençal escape.

Location & Local Information

Maison Paradis is located 27km south of Avignon in Les Alpilles Natural Regional Park, around 2km from the picture-perfect village of Eygalières. Set around 200m off a country lane, the house and its vast grounds are reached via a track shared with a neighbouring residence. It's only 11km to reach Saint-Rémy-de-Provence with its town amenities, upmarket restaurants and large supermarkets.

The nearby village of Eygalières (2km) is a picturesque gem with its narrow cobblestone streets, restaurant terraces and timeless architecture, exuding an irresistible old-world charm. Surrounded by olive groves, vineyards, lavender and farmland, Eygalières offers an idyllic retreat for nature enthusiasts, culture lovers, and history buffs alike. From its historic church perched on the hilltop to the stunning views of Les Alpilles, every corner of Eygalières invites you to slow down, savour the moment, and immerse yourself in the beauty of Provence.

Les Alpilles Natural Regional Park is a treasure trove of natural and cultural wonders. Spanning rugged limestone peaks, verdant valleys, and tranquil plains, this protected area is a haven for outdoor adventurers. Embark on scenic hiking or cycling trails that wind through the region, revealing panoramic vistas along the way. Don't miss the opportunity to explore the ancient Roman ruins at Glanum (12km) or visit Carrières des Lumières (20km), where art and light converge in a mesmerising display within a former quarry.

For those seeking a deeper connection to the region's heritage, local markets, wineries, and olive mills offer an authentic taste of Provençal life. Highlights include Maussane-les-Alpilles (18km), known for its olive oil production, and Les Baux-de-Provence (20km), classified as one of France's 'Plus Beaux Villages'.

A little further afield, venture to the Luberon region of Provence for more incredible landscapes, rich heritage, wine-tasting opportunities and idyllic perched villages









such as Gordes, Ménerbes and Roussillon, all reached within 45 minutes by car.
