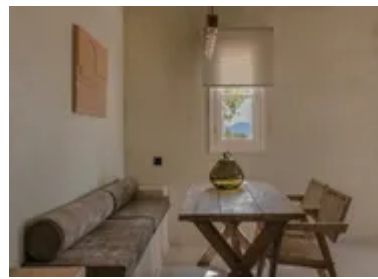

Location & Local Information

Villa Ulla is located in the charming village of Assos, one of Kefalonia's most picturesque and unspoiled destinations. Nestled on the island's northwest coast, Assos is known for its traditional Ionian architecture, serene atmosphere, and breathtaking coastal scenery.
