Overview

This beautifully restored 18th-century farmhouse offers a perfect blend of historic character and modern charm with breathtaking views of the Dordogne countryside and vineyards.

Le Pigeonnier features an inviting central courtyard with festoon lighting for atmospheric al-fresco feasts and a stunning swimming pool with glorious vistas. Whether you are entertaining guests on warm summer evenings or cosying up by the fireplace in cooler months, this exceptional home provides a unique sanctuary in one of France's most captivating regions.

Step inside and be transported back in time, where original stone walls, beamed ceilings, and old fireplaces have been lovingly preserved and enhanced by skilled local artisans. The expansive ground floor boasts a bespoke kitchen with high-end appliances, a light-filled dining room with direct access to the courtyard, and two lounge areas, each exuding warmth and character. Across two floors, five good-sized bedrooms are restful retreats, including a gorgeous master double with a super king-size bed, freestanding bath, walk-in rainfall shower and dressing area.

Outside, the extensive grounds stretch across eight acres, perfect for outdoor games or simply soaking in the rural surroundings. A hidden gem overlooking the swimming pool is the historic pigeonier, an enchanting and shady space to unwind with a glass of local wine as the sun sets over the landscape.

Le Pigeonnier is ideally situated between the renowned wine regions of Bergerac and Saint-Émilion, with an array of attractions and activities for visitors. Just a short drive away, the medieval town of Sainte-Foy-la-Grande comes



alive every Saturday with its vibrant market, where you can sample fresh local produce and artisanal delights.

For those who enjoy fine dining and world-class wines, Château des Vigiers boasts Michelin-starred cuisine and an exceptional golf course. Meanwhile, adventure seekers can explore the Dordogne River by kayak, cycle through scenic vineyard trails, or take a leisurely stroll through nearby villages such as Gensac and Pessac-sur-Dordogne.

Whether you seek a countryside escape, an idyllic retreat for entertaining, or an adventure-filled getaway close to the Dordogne River, this alluring abode offers something for everyone in the Gironde region of southwestern France.

Location & Local Information

This historic home is set in eight acres of grounds, close to the banks of the Dordogne River. Near the small village of Eynesse, Le Pigeonnier offers a wonderful base from which to explore the Gironde and Dordogne regions as well as the many treasures of southwestern France.

The house is reached via a winding driveway, located just off the country road that follows the Dordogne River between Eynesse and Sainte-Foy-la-Grande. This is otherwise a rural setting (with just one other neighbouring property next door). Eynesse (1.6km) is home to a bistro - you can walk along the country road (no pavement) or it's a very short drive. The most adventurous could even follow a track through the forest to reach the village.

It's wonderful to be so near the Dordogne River – discover fishing opportunities nearby and look out for canoeing/kayaking as well as lovely riverside walks in Pessac-sur-Dordogne (9km).

Located between Bergerac and Bordeaux, and only a 33km drive to Saint-Émilion, this is a superb area for wine-tasting. You can walk through nearby woodland to a neighbouring wine chateaux dating back to the 17th century. A little further afield, the vineyards of Gensac (10km) and Duras (21km) offer a chance to taste some of the region's finest wines, produced in a landscape steeped in tradition.

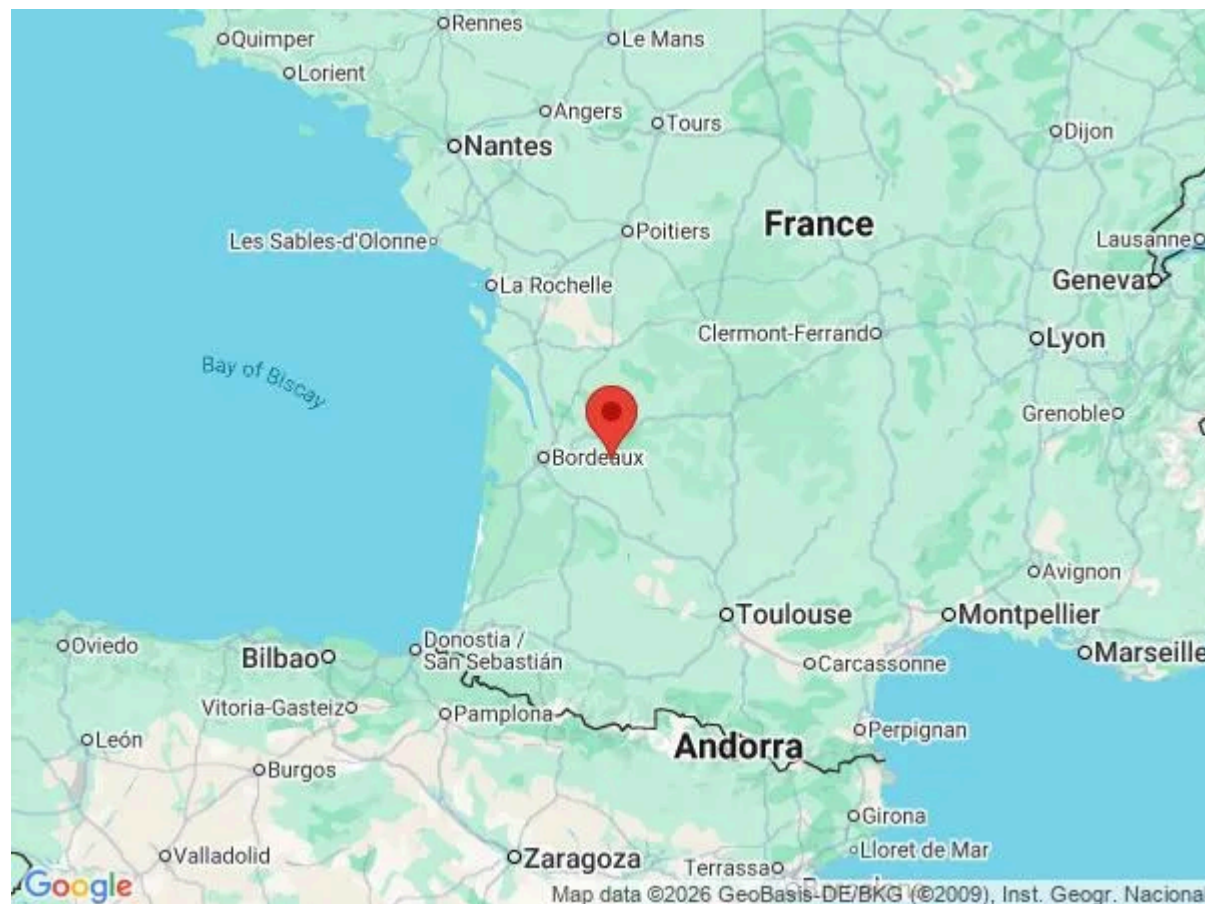
The charming town of Sainte-Foy-la-Grande (5.5km), known for its medieval streets and vibrant market, is just a stone's throw away. Wander through its cobbled lanes and explore the impressive 13th-century church or the bustling market square that comes alive on a Saturday morning when it hosts one of the area's most beautiful markets.

It's also worth noting that the train station in Sainte-Foy-la-Grande has departures towards Bordeaux, Bergerac and Sarlat for wonderful days out across the region.

Stroll along the banks of the Dordogne River in Bergerac (29km) or visit the Musée du Tabac to delve into the area's fascinating history. Dine in traditional restaurants and savour fine cuisine accompanied by good local wine, and look out for the vibrant markets that take place across the attractive town centre. South of the town, Château de Monbazillac (30km) is famous for producing the region's sweet white wine.

For a touch of grandeur, head west towards Bordeaux (78km), a city renowned for its stunning architecture, including the iconic Place de la Bourse and its glorious riverside views. Whether you're browsing the local boutiques, sampling wines across the city's bars or sipping coffee in one of the charming cafés, Bordeaux offers an unforgettable experience.

In the surrounding countryside, you'll find the beautiful hills and valleys of the region, ideal for cycling, hiking, or simply enjoying the tranquillity of nature. What's more, the prestigious Château des Vigiers (14.5km) is a short distance away with its 18-hole golf course, spa and Michelin starred restaurant.

What you should know...

- The ceilings and traditional wood beams are low in the upstairs bedrooms.
- It's lovely to have the village bistro just a short distance away - it's less than a 5-minute drive or you can walk along the country road (no pavement or lighting). During the day, the most adventurous of guests can even follow a track through the forest to reach the village.
- There are outbuildings backing onto the courtyard and facing the opposite direction which are not in use. Please rest assured guests will have exclusive use of the property, amenities and pool etc.
