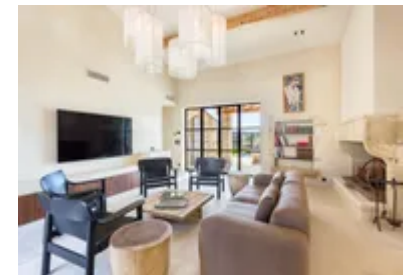
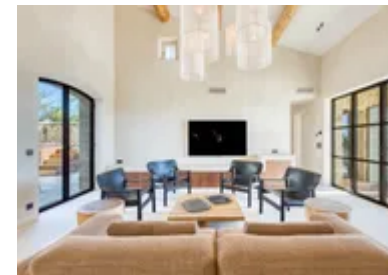
Location & Local Information
