Overview

Discover Montalcino's fine wine, artistic treasures and historic charm as you stay in this beautiful borgo located in one of Tuscany's most enchanting hilltop villages. After a day out exploring the iconic landscapes of the Val d'Orcia, it's wonderful to cool off in your swimming pool or relax in the hot tub before wandering to the heart of the village for delicious food accompanied by some of Italy's most famous wine.

Having undergone a complete renovation, Hamlet In Montalcino welcomes up to 12 guests and showcases the perfect blend of contemporary flair and original Tuscan character across its bedrooms and living spaces. Rooms are individually styled, each one with its own unique features, scattered across the *borgo*. Five of the six bedrooms feature king-size beds (that can be split into two singles) and they all have their own modern bath or shower room – one even has its own bath tub romantically standing in the room.

Listen to the church bells as you sit back in the hot tub or gaze up at Montalcino's old houses as you gather by the firepit. It's a joy to have such a spacious garden in a village setting – embrace the scent of rosemary and lavender before firing up the barbecue or enjoying pizza nights by the traditional wood-burning oven. The swimming pool is of course another highlight for warm summer days or there is ample space to simply enjoy a glass of Brunello di Montalcino in glorious surroundings.

Breakfast is served each morning and daily cleaning is included. The owners can also arrange an array of other services from a chef to prepare gourmet meals to winetasting, massages, yoga, bike rental and more.

with its inviting *trattorie* serving delicious local fare as well as pretty squares, artisan shops, wine bars, churches and the 14th century fortress – climb to the historic walls to admire stunning views of the Val d'Orcia landscapes.

Pass iconic landscapes of cypress trees, rolling hills and vineyards as you explore this idyllic part of Italy. Visit other Tuscan gems such as Pienza, Montepulciano and Siena before returning to your very own Montalcino holiday abode in this privileged and picturesque setting.

Location & Local Information

Surrounded by the dreamy landscapes of the Val D'Orcia, Hamlet In Montalcino is located in one of Tuscany's most charming hilltop villages, known for its prestigious Brunello di Montalcino wine. As well as embracing the beauty and rich heritage of Montalcino, this is a fine base for exploring other gems of southern Tuscany including Montepulciano, Pienza and Siena.

The *borgo* is set at the bottom of the hill, just below the town walls. It is a true privilege to be able to walk to the restaurants, wineries and historic sights of Montalcino, a destination that embodies history, culture, and world-renowned wine. There is private parking at the property (a rarity in Montalcino, especially in summer months) but you will need to a permit to drive through Montalcino's traffic restricted zones (please arrange with the owner well in advance).

Wander around the village's charming cobbled streets passing old churches, artisan shops and traditional restaurants serving local specialities. Walk up to the imposing 14th century fortress and gaze at the breathtaking views over the Val d'Orcia. A 10km drive from the village, visit the Abbazia di Sant'Antimo, a Romanesque masterpiece dating back centuries, a historic jewel of Tuscany.

Pass sweeping panoramas of the Val d'Orcia as you discover other gorgeous villages and towns. Cypress-lined roads, golden wheat fields and rolling hills create such beautiful Tuscan landscapes. Fall in love with Pienza (23km) and admire its perfect Renaissance architecture. Designed as the "ideal city" by Pope Pius II, Pienza is a UNESCO World Heritage Site famed for its picturesque streets, charming squares, and the rich Pecorino cheese that fills the air with its unmistakable aroma.

Montepulciano (36km) stands as another Tuscan gem, known for its elegant palazzi and vineyards producing Vino Nobile di Montepulciano. Stroll through the town's narrow alleys and grand squares, stopping for wine tasting in one of its historic cellars. No visit to the region is complete without exploring Siena (42km), one of Italy's most loved towns with its iconic historic sites including the vast Piazza del Campo, home of the annual Palio horse race.
