


Location & Local Information

Kalkan is a charming coastal town on Turkey's southwestern Mediterranean coast, known for its stunning scenery, turquoise waters, and sophisticated yet relaxed atmosphere. Nestled between the towering Taurus Mountains and the shimmering sea, Kalkan offers a picturesque setting that attracts visitors looking for a mix of natural beauty, history, and a touch of luxury. Originally a small fishing village, it has retained its authentic charm while evolving into a sought-after destination for discerning travellers.

One of Kalkan's most distinctive features is its whitewashed houses cascading down the hillside, adorned with vibrant bougainvillea and offering breathtaking sea views. The town is famous for its charming old town, where narrow, winding streets are lined with boutique shops, traditional cafés, and rooftop restaurants serving delicious Turkish and Mediterranean cuisine. - While the villa has a private pool and designated sunbathing area, it is part of a seven-villa development with shared waterfront platforms. Guests seeking complete seclusion may find the communal setup less ideal.
- The villa's peaceful location in Kalamar Bay is great for relaxation, but it means guests will need transport to reach Kalkan's restaurants, shops, and nightlife. While taxis are available, those who prefer to walk everywhere may find it less convenient.
- The villa is perfect for couples or small groups, but with just one master bedroom, it may not suit families with children or larger parties.

Terms & Conditions

- **Security deposit:** There is no security deposit, but should there be any damage or loss caused by you or your guests during your stay you will be liable for the cost
- **Arrival time:** 15.00
- **Departure time:** 10.00
- **Energy costs included?:** Yes, included in rental price
- **Linen & towels included?:** Yes, included in rental price
- **Pets welcome?:** Not allowed
- **Other Ts and Cs:** Please note that on occasions, in Turkey, extremes in weather can cause water and/ or electric supply to be cut or reduced. Services are normally restored as soon as possible.
- **Changeover day:** Flexible
- **End of stay cleaning available?:** Yes. However, guests are required to leave the accommodation clean, tidy and in the same condition as on their arrival.
- **Smoking Allowed?:** Not permitted
- **Other 2:** In Turkey the plumbing system is not designed to have paper and sanitary items flushed down the lavatory. In these cases a bathroom bin is provided.
- **Insurance:** Guests are required to be in possession of a valid insurance policy, which covers them for cancellations, personal belongings, personal liability and any accidental damage caused during their stay.
- **Minimum stay:** 7 nights
- **Pool heating charge?:** For those who require pool heating, there will be an additional charge of £200 per week (to be paid to OT prior to travel). Please note that like all heated pools, pool heating and water temperature are reliant on weather and outside temperatures. Maximum temperatures of 24-25°C can be achieved if outside temperature is cool.
- **Internet access?:** The property has complimentary Wifi connection. It is good to note that the speed is dependent on local provider and technical issues may cause reduced speed or cut of service.

All British (and most other nationalities) citizens require a full 10-year passport with at least 6 months validity to enter Turkey. UK passport holders are exempt from visa for tourist visits of up to 90 days within 180 days starting from the first entry date. For all other passports please visit the Turkish Government Website (<https://www.evisa.gov.tr/en/>) or the *Turkish Consulate* for details of whether you require a visa or not.

Whilst in Turkey local regulations require you keep your passport and a printed copy of your e-visa with you at all times.
