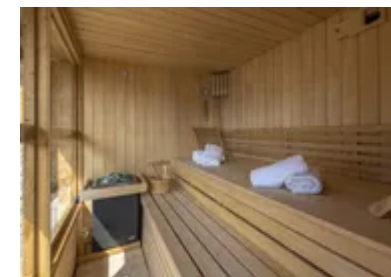
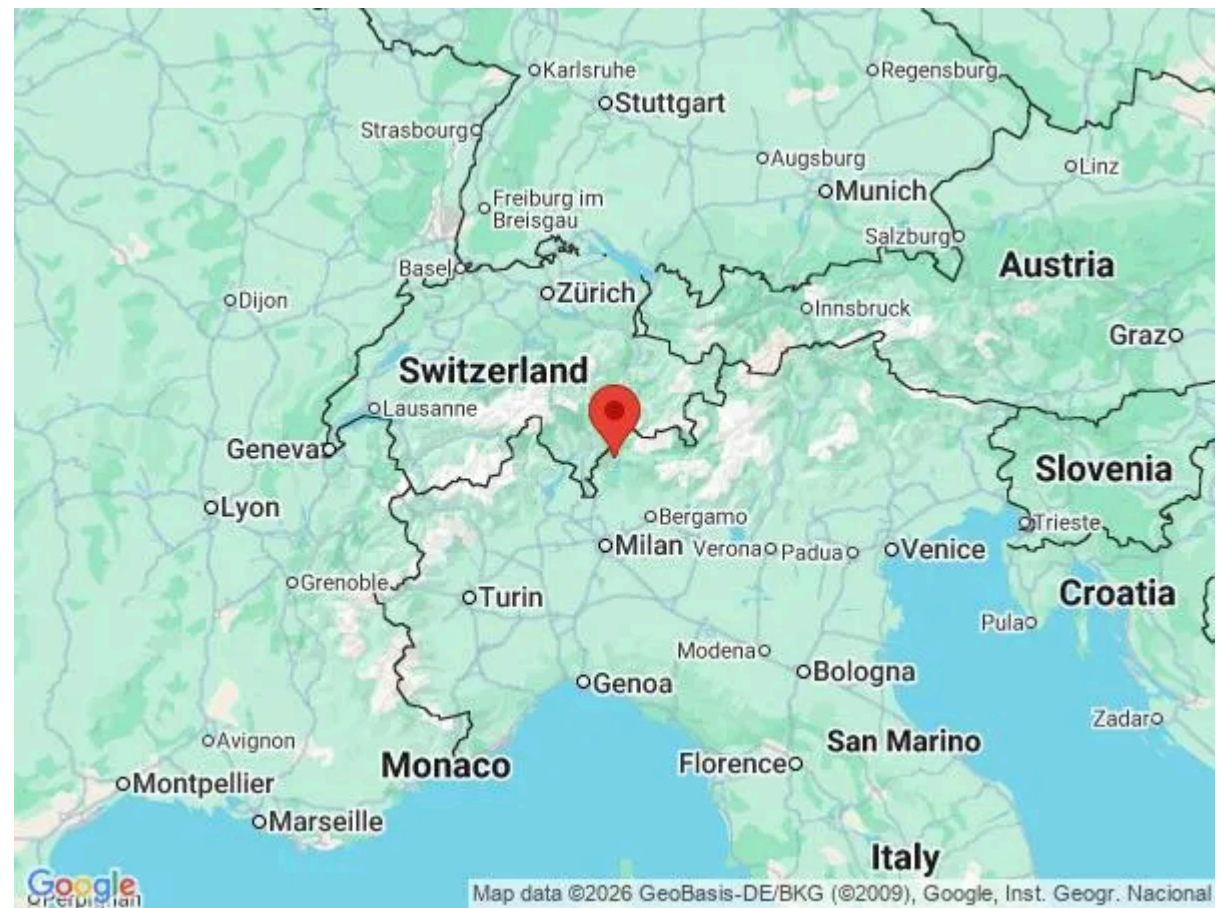
Location & Local Information

- The villa is located on a hill, which means there are steep slopes leading up to the property; a car is essential for access, and is highly recommended to explore the local area.
- The two smaller attic bedrooms are best suited for children or one adult, as they are more compact in size.
- While the infinity pool is perfect for relaxation, the maximum depth is 1.2m, so it may not be ideal for those seeking a deeper swimming experience.
- The pool is not fenced, so children should be supervised when outdoors.
- The property is in a tranquil, rural location, which means some amenities and restaurants are a short drive away.
