Location & Local Information

In the picturesque Eure department of Normandy, not far from the banks of the Seine, this area offers a tranquil retreat with effortless access to some of France's most iconic destinations. Whether you seek historic châteaux, invigorating nature trails or inspiration from the landscapes that captivated Monet, La Commanderie is an ideal base just west of Paris.

From a practical point of view, La Commanderie is in a tiny rural village. It's around a 5 to 10-minute drive to another slightly larger village with a new restaurant (book ahead), bakery, small supermarket and train station. There are further amenities in places such as picturesque Pacy-sur-Eure (11km) and riverside Rosny-sur-Seine (15km).

Less than half an hour away lies Giverny (23km), the enchanting village where Claude Monet created his masterpiece gardens. Stroll through the famous water lily pond, wander beneath the wisteria-clad bridges, and immerse yourself in the world of Impressionism at the Musée des Impressionnismes.

For those drawn to history and stunning river landscapes, La Roche-Guyon (22km) awaits with its medieval château perched dramatically on the Seine's banks, offering breathtaking views and a journey through centuries of French heritage. La Roche-Guyon is officially classified as one of France's 'Plus Beaux Villages'.

A visit to the nearby town of Vernon (20km) offers another glimpse of Normandy's riverside charm. Set along the banks of the Seine, this picturesque town boasts half-timbered houses, a striking medieval bridge, and the elegant Collégiale Notre-Dame. Enjoy a leisurely stroll along the river, explore the Musée de Vernon, or admire the famous Old Mill, an enchanting sight that feels like a painting come to life.

Meanwhile, the Vexin Français Regional Nature Park, with its vast meadows, woodlands, and charming villages, invites outdoor enthusiasts to hike, cycle, or simply soak in the beauty of unspoiled nature.

For an unforgettable day out, step into the grandeur of Versailles (65km), where the opulent palace and its exquisite gardens reveal the splendour of French royalty. Alternatively, venture to Paris (82km), the City of Light, and lose yourself in its world-class museums, charming cafés, and vibrant streets. Trains depart from Bueil (3.5km) taking just over 60 minutes to Paris Saint Lazare or it's around a 90-minute drive.

If the sea beckons, the Normandy coast offers perfect day trips – Honfleur (132km), with its artistic harbour and timber-framed houses, or Deauville (125km), renowned for its beach, boardwalk, boutiques and overall elegant seaside charm.
