Villa Soleil Levant is a fine example of Provençal charm, offering the perfect blend of traditional character and modern comfort alongside a gorgeous garden with olive trees and a private swimming pool. It's wonderful to be able to stroll to the heart of Paradou for morning pastries, coffee on a café terrace or lunch out in one of Provence's most loved bistros.

Fully renovated, this spacious 6-bedroom home exudes a welcoming atmosphere that combines the grandeur of wood-beamed ceilings and exposed stone with contemporary touches. At the heart of the villa is the expansive living room, where natural light pours in, and a striking stone fireplace creates a cosy focal point. The well-equipped kitchen features a Lacanche range cooker, a wine cellar, and a cool room, ensuring everything needed for a memorable dining experience is within reach.

The main house boasts five en suite bedrooms, including one on the ground floor for added convenience. For extra flexibility, an independent studio with its own shower room and side kitchen provides a garden retreat for guests seeking a little independence.

Outside, embrace the perfect setting for relaxation. A heated swimming pool invites guests to cool off, while a pool house provides a comfortable space to unwind, also ideal for enjoying meals outdoors or simply soaking up the Provençal atmosphere. There are other pretty spots to savour your morning espresso, read a book or drink local wine on warm summer evenings.

Located just a short walk from the charming village of Paradou, Villa Soleil Levant is perfectly positioned to explore the stunning landscapes of Les Alpilles. With nearby places such as Saint-Rémy-de-Provence and Les Baux-de-Provence, guests can easily discover the region's rich history, beautiful scenery and renowned vineyards. Location & Local Information


Paradou offers an authentic escape where the charm of traditional village life meets the breathtaking landscapes of the Alpilles. The villa is located on the edge of the village in a residential area, less than 1km from the heart of Paradou.

The village of Paradou is the epitome of Provençal charm. Meander through its pretty streets, where you'll find a café-restaurant, butchers, boulangerie and grocery store. Be sure to visit Le Bistrot du Paradou, a regional favourite offering Le Plat du Jour in a warm, welcoming atmosphere. For those who enjoy a little adventure, bike hire is readily available, offering a perfect opportunity to explore the surrounding olive groves at your own pace.

Just a short distance from Paradou lies Maussane-les-Alpilles (2.5km), a picturesque village loved for its vibrant Friday morning market. Here, you'll find an array of fresh local produce, handmade goods, and local olive oil. The stunning village of Les Baux-de-Provence (5km) is another must-visit. Perched atop a rocky outcrop, it offers panoramic views of the surrounding valley. As you wander through its cobbled streets, you'll encounter medieval ruins, charming boutiques, and art galleries, making it an unforgettable destination for history lovers and culture enthusiasts alike.

For those who enjoy the great outdoors, Les Alpilles region in Provence offer a variety of hiking trails, mountain biking routes, and opportunities for rock climbing. The region's rolling hills, olive groves, forests and rugged cliffs create a stunning backdrop for any outdoor activity. Whether you're a seasoned adventurer or just looking for a peaceful stroll, the landscapes of Les Alpilles won't disappoint.

Just a short drive away, Arles (16km) offers a rich cultural experience with its Roman ruins and vibrant arts scene. Arles is also the gateway to the Camargue with its unique and wild landscapes, famous for its white horses, flamingos, and salt flats. Whether you're horse-riding



through its landscapes or simply enjoying a peaceful boat ride, the Camargue is an extraordinary place to reconnect with nature.
