Upstairs, you'll find two charming bedrooms. The main double features a king-size bed and an en-suite bathroom with a romantic bath, while the second bedroom offers a queen-size bed and its own shower room.

Step outside to unwind by the saltwater swimming pool, surrounded by a poolside terrace and sun loungers. As evening falls, gather for outdoor meals and enjoy seasonal produce from local markets, paired with fine Provençal wine from Saint-Rémy, the Rhône Valley, or the Luberon.

Pave Blanche is ideally located for exploring the wonders of Provence. Arles is a UNESCO World Heritage site, offering a rich history, stunning Roman architecture, and vibrant cultural attractions. Meanwhile, the landscapes of both the Camargue and Les Alpilles, along with the impressive Pont du Gard and the Roman city of Nîmes, provide endless opportunities for adventure.

Location & Local Information

In the Bouches-du-Rhône department of southern France, Pave Blanche is located only 7km from Arles and a 40-minute drive from Nimes and Avignon. The small villa is set just off the road connecting Arles and Fontvieille, a prime location for exploring this part of Provence.

Arles offers a rich blend of history, art, and natural beauty. Known for its striking Roman ruins and its connection to Vincent van Gogh, this vibrant town will captivate you at every turn. Explore the ancient Roman Amphitheatre, stroll through the charming cobbled streets, visit art galleries and enjoy the striking architecture that captures the essence of centuries gone by. Arles is not just a place to visit; it's an experience to savour.

Just a short drive in the other direction, Fontvieille (7.5km) beckons with its picturesque landscapes and historical charm. Walk the famous windmill trail, where you'll find the iconic Moulin de Daudet, featured in Alphonse Daudet's beloved tales. Along the way, the views over the rolling hills of Provence are nothing short of breathtaking. A visit to the Abbaye de Montmajour (10km) is also a must—this serene site, dating back to the 10th century, offers a glimpse into the region's monastic past and is the perfect place to reflect on the timeless beauty of Provence.

For those seeking natural beauty, Les Alpilles offers some of the most stunning landscapes in Provence. The charming villages of Les Baux-de-Provence (16km) and Maussane-les-Alpilles (15.5km) are set against the backdrop of limestone hills, olive trees, and forests. Like Arles, St-Rémy (25km) is renowned for its connection to Vincent van Gogh, who painted some of his most famous works here.

Meanwhile, venture south to the Camargue, a unique natural region where wild white horses, flamingos, and salt flats create an untamed landscape like no other. Explore this wetland paradise by foot, bike, or on horseback, and experience the untouched beauty of one of Europe's most fascinating ecosystems. The region is also home to









traditional bullfighting and picturesque villages, offering a glimpse into local life.

If you can find the time, no visit to this part of France would be complete without a trip to Nimes (38km). Marvel at the exceptional Roman architecture, from the perfectly preserved Arènes de Nîmes to the majestic Maison Carrée. Just outside the city, the iconic Le Pont du Gard (40km) spans the Gardon River and is an engineering marvel that continues to awe visitors today.
