Location & Local Information

A 15-minute drive north of Aix-en-Provence, Maison D'Art is located in the suburbs of this beautiful Provençal town.

Set in vast gardens, the villa enjoys a semi-rural setting on the edge of a village and is well located for amenities such as supermarket within a 3-minute drive. A little further, around 2km away, there is a pretty village church, a couple of restaurants, useful shops and a Friday morning market. Don't miss the wonderful *chocolaterie* on the other side of the village around 3km away - look out for tours and workshops.

A single track railway line runs parallel to the edge of Maison D'Art's grounds (it is not a busy line), just across the lane. The nearest train station for regional journeys is in the centre of Aix-en-Provence whilst the TGV train station (with arrivals from Paris) is 20km away.

Aix-en-Provence (7km) is a town where centuries of history, art, and Provençal charm blend seamlessly with modern refinement. Known for its elegant boulevards, pastel-hued mansions, and lively café culture, Aix captures the essence of southern France in every cobbled street and shaded square. Whether you're exploring bustling markets beneath plane trees or following in the footsteps of Cézanne, the spirit of Provence lingers in the warm air and golden light.

Art and culture are woven into the very fabric of the town and its surroundings. At the striking Vasarely Foundation just outside the centre, visitors are immersed in the vibrant world of optical art, where bold geometric patterns and architectural wonder collide. Meanwhile, the Granet Museum, set within a former 17th-century priory, houses an impressive collection ranging from classical works to pieces by Cézanne, Picasso, and Giacometti. For lovers of art, history, and design, Aix offers an inspiring feast for the senses.

Beyond the town, nature takes centre stage. The majestic Sainte-Victoire mountain, immortalised by Cézanne's brushstrokes, rises proudly above a landscape dotted with charming stone villages and sunlit vineyards. Spend a day hiking scenic trails, visiting quaint hilltop hamlets, or indulging in a guided wine-tasting tour to sample the region's excellent wines.

If you can find the time, venture into the enchanting Luberon region, where time seems to slow among the ochre-hued villages of Lourmarin (28km), Ansouis (31km), and Cucuron (33km). Each offers a postcard-perfect blend of winding lanes, artisan boutiques, and gastronomic delights (some restaurants with Michelin stars), ideal for leisurely days exploring Provençal life at its finest. Don't miss the seasonal markets, bursting with lavender, olives, and local cheeses.

For a taste of the coast, the azure waters of Cassis (57km) beckon around an hour away. Here, colourful fishing boats bob in the harbour, and dramatic limestone fjords await discovery in the breathtaking Calanques National Park. Whether by foot or boat, the sparkling coves and hidden beaches offer a serene contrast to the region's inland treasures.
