Location & Local Information

In the Vaucluse countryside of southern France, the village of Cheval Blanc is located just outside the market town of Cavaillon. The villa is located in a residential neighbourhood on the edge of the village with a bakery, bar-tabac and church around 500m away whilst it's 1.5km to reach another part of the village with a restaurant and other amenities. Meanwhile, you will find a choice of supermarkets on the edge of Cavaillon just 5 to 10 minutes by car.

Venture a little further and you'll find yourself immersed in the rolling landscapes of the Luberon, home to some of the most beautiful villages in France. Meander through the cobbled streets of Ménerbes (16km), Gordes (20km) or Roussillon (28km), where stone houses cling to the hillsides and cafés spill out onto sunny squares. It's a region where every bend in the road reveals a postcard view—ripe with colour, culture and Provençal authenticity.

A short drive brings you to L'Isle-sur-la-Sorgue (15km), a town famed for its antique markets and romantic canals. Known as the "Venice of Provence", it's a must-visit for lovers of art, history and hidden treasures. Equally enchanting are Les Alpilles, where craggy hills cradle timeless villages and towns like Eygalières (16.5km)—a hilltop gem with panoramic views—and Saint-Rémy-de-Provence (23km), beloved by Van Gogh and alive with galleries, boutiques and weekly markets.

For a taste of grandeur, set off on a day trip to Avignon (30km), the former seat of Popes, where medieval ramparts and the soaring Palais des Papes speak to a regal past. Or head south to Aix-en-Provence (52km), a city of fountains, tree-lined boulevards and sunlit terraces that once inspired Cézanne. Both destinations are under an hour away, making them perfect for a cultural day out.
