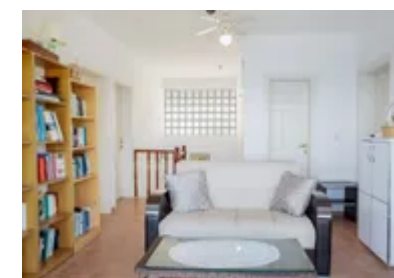
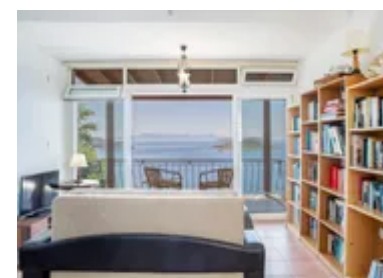
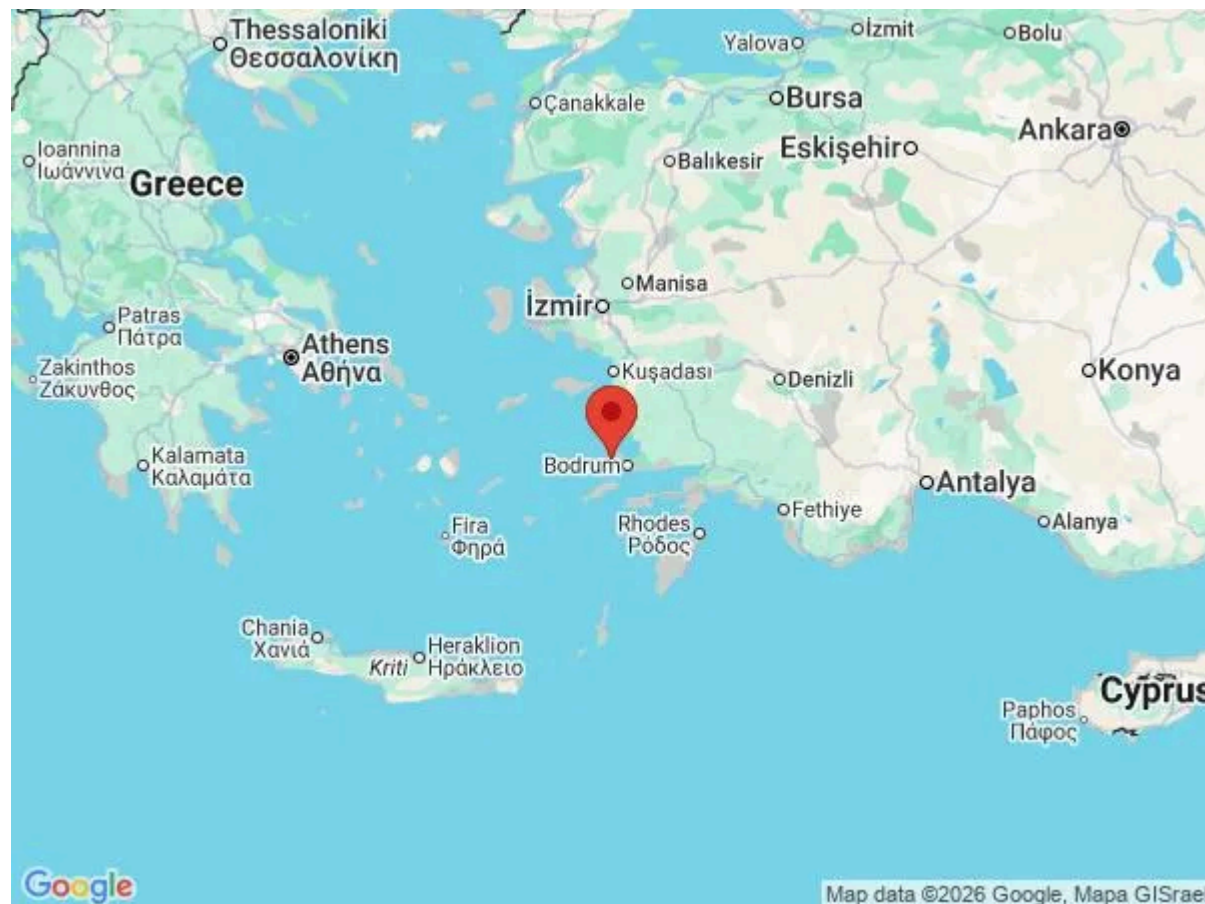
Location & Local Information

Nestled in the tranquil hills of Gumusluk, Villa Pazar enjoys a wonderfully peaceful setting with a real sense of escape yet remains close to all the essentials. Just a short drive away lies the heart of Gumusluk village, a charming coastal spot famed for its laid-back vibe, artisan shops, and seafront restaurants serving freshly caught seafood. The area is steeped in history – the ancient city of Myndos once stood here, and remnants of its submerged ruins can still be seen glimmering beneath the water near Rabbit Island.

For everyday needs, you'll find local markets, bakeries, and small supermarkets within easy reach. The surrounding area is a haven for walkers, foodies, and beach lovers alike. Spend your days paddling in the shallows, exploring local hiking routes, or enjoying open-air jazz at sunset. Gumusluk is also known for its artistic soul, hosting music festivals, craft fairs, and a creative community that adds even more colour to this already captivating corner of Bodrum.

- The pool is not heated and may feel cool outside the peak summer months.
- The property is set in a quiet hillside area – ideal for peace and privacy, though not within immediate walking distance of central amenities.

Terms & Conditions

- **Security deposit:** €500 charged to client's credit card by the owner before/upon arrival and refunded two weeks after departure, subject to full inspection.
- **Arrival time:** 16.00
- **Departure time:** 10.00
- **Energy costs included?:** Yes, included in rental price
- **Linen & towels included?:** Yes, included in rental price
- **Pets welcome?:** Not allowed
- **Other Ts and Cs:** Please note that on occasions, in Turkey, extremes in weather can cause water and/ or electric supply to be cut or reduced. Services are normally restored as soon as possible.
- **Changeover day:** Flexible
- **End of stay cleaning available?:** Extra €250, paid locally. However, guests are required to leave the accommodation clean, tidy and in the same condition as on their arrival. Any extra cleaning, laundry, maintenance and/or garbage disposal required will be charged against the security deposit.
- **Smoking Allowed?:** Not permitted
- **Other 2:** In Turkey the plumbing system is not designed to have paper and sanitary items flushed down the lavatory. In these cases a bathroom bin is provided.
- **Insurance:** Guests are required to be in possession of a valid insurance policy, which covers them for cancellations, personal belongings, personal liability and any accidental damage caused during their stay.
- **Minimum stay:** 3 nights - low/mid season 5 nights - high season
- **Internet access?:** The property has complimentary Wifi connection. It is good to note that the speed is dependent on local provider and technical issues may cause reduced speed or cut of service.

Travelling to Turkey

All British (and most other nationalities) citizens require a full 10 year passport with at least 6 months validity to enter Turkey. UK passport holders are exempt from visa for tourist visits of up to 90 days within 180 days starting from the first entry date. For all other passports please visit the Turkish Government Website (<https://www.evisa.gov.tr/en/>) or the Turkish Consulate for details of whether you require a visa or not.

Whilst in Turkey local regulations require you keep your passport and a printed copy of your e-visa with you at all times.
