Overview

Embrace the aroma of orange trees at this beautiful Mediterranean villa with a private swimming pool set in the most wonderful garden, just a short drive from the heart of historic Jávea and its much-loved beaches.

Villa Noa Noa is a warm and welcoming villa with lovely owners who have created such a special and unique home, partly inspired by their upbringing in Tahiti. Step inside and soak up the relaxing vibe of the open-plan living area with its Smart TV, Bluetooth turntable and customdesigned wooden dining table. The pretty kitchen is brilliantly equipped and opens out to the garden whilst the ground floor also features three comfortable double bedrooms with high-end cotton linen and fans alongside two marble shower rooms.

Upstairs, discover the light-filled master bedroom with airconditioning and glorious views of the sea – you may even be able to see as far as Ibiza on clear days. The en suite marble bathroom offers an Italian shower and decadent bath tub and there is a large office space with a desk, sofa and yet more Mediterranean vistas.

Outside, a traditional terrace made out of native Tosca stone awaits for relaxation and al-fresco dining beside the bougainvillea and jasmine. Meanwhile, the south-west facing swimming pool is surrounded by sun loungers, daybeds and a large olive tree. Follow the steps down to the lower garden, a true paradise with orange trees, flowers and three delightful Tahitian-style houses, the perfect spot for yoga or for massages (that can be arranged on request). Families will especially love the ping-pong table, darts, pétanque, outdoor projector and other games.

This is such a gorgeous and private setting in a secure







residential neighbourhood. It's a short drive to a supermarket and shops whilst Jávea is only 6km by car with its medieval quarter, markets, pretty shops and restaurants overlooking the Mediterranean. Spend family time at nearby Playa Arenal, a sandy beach backed by summer restaurants, or discover the stunning coves of Portixol and Granadella for snorkelling and kayaking.

Further afield, the likes of Calpe and Altea await for delightful excursions or hop on a boat tour for swimming in the coves, sunset cruises or sailing as far as Denia. At the end of the day, return to Villa Noa Noa, fire up the barbecue and enjoy a chilled bottle of wine from a local vineyard as you appreciate the charm of this Costa Blanca gem.

Location & Local Information

Tucked between dramatic cliffs and the turquoise waters of the Costa Blanca, Jávea offers a slice of Mediterranean paradise that blends traditional charm with a relaxed seaside allure. Villa Noa Noa enjoys a privileged location in a private and secure estate in a beautiful neighbourhood named El Tosalet, just a short drive from central Jávea, almost equidistant to Alicante and Valencia airports. A highlight of this neighbourhood is that it offers 24-hour security, giving families that peace of mind during their stay.

Whether you're meandering through the narrow cobbled streets of the old town, soaking up the sunshine on café terraces, picking up delights at the weekly market or dining al fresco with views of the glistening bay, Jávea (6km) welcomes you with an effortless elegance that's hard to resist. With its pleasant climate and easy-going pace, this coastal gem is a favourite for those seeking beauty, tranquillity, and authentic Spanish culture.

One of Jávea's star attractions is Playa Arenal (4 km) a lively crescent of soft sand flanked by cafes and restaurants. Perfect for families and those who enjoy a sociable beachfront atmosphere, it offers shallow waters, windsurfing and plenty of space to unwind. For a more secluded experience, close by are the breathtaking Cala del Portixol (4 km) and Playa de la Granadella (5 km), two of the region's most stunning coves. These postcard-perfect hideaways offer crystal-clear waters ideal for snorkelling and kayaking – park up early in the summer as both are popular spots.

For those wanting to explore the coastline from a different perspective, boat trips from Jávea are a must. Choose from leisurely catamaran cruises at sunset to private charters that weave through sea caves and along dramatic cliffs. The marine life is abundant, and the views back toward the town from the water are simply unforgettable. It's a unique way to connect with the landscape and soak in the coastal splendour.









If you fancy a change of scene, day trips to nearby Moraira (14 km), Calpe (25 km), or the whitewashed town of Altea (40 km) make for delightful excursions. Each offers its own character: Moraira is peaceful and picturesque with a chic marina; Calpe boasts a dramatic rock formation, the Peñón de Ifach, and excellent seafood; while Altea enchants with its bohemian spirit, blue-domed church, and artist-filled streets. Roughly a 25-minute drive from the villa is also the ferry port to go to Ibiza or Formentera; two gorgeous islands that are great for a day trip!
