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## Overview

Villa Kythera is a charming two-storey retreat tucked away on the serene seafront of Eretria, Evia. Stepping inside, you're greeted by a sense of calm and brightness—natural light spills through tall French windows, dancing across polished wooden floors and crisp white walls. The interiors are tastefully updated, blending comfort with subtle elegance. With two air-conditioned bedrooms, a full bathroom, an extra toilet, and a spacious living area, the house warmly accommodates up to five guests. The kitchen is thoughtfully equipped, perfect for leisurely breakfasts or evening meals shared indoors or outside.

Slide open the shutters and wander onto the stone-tiled terrace, where rustic wooden chairs and a sea-facing table invite you to linger over coffee or a good book. The villa's lush garden offers shaded nooks under pine trees, and the sound of waves is your constant backdrop. While there's no pool, the Aegean Sea is just steps away, clear, blue, and endlessly inviting.

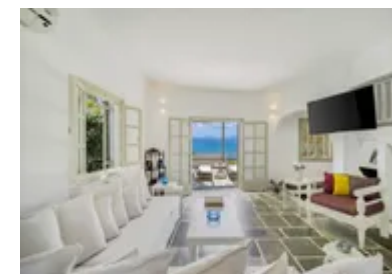
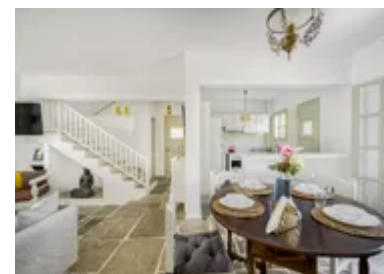
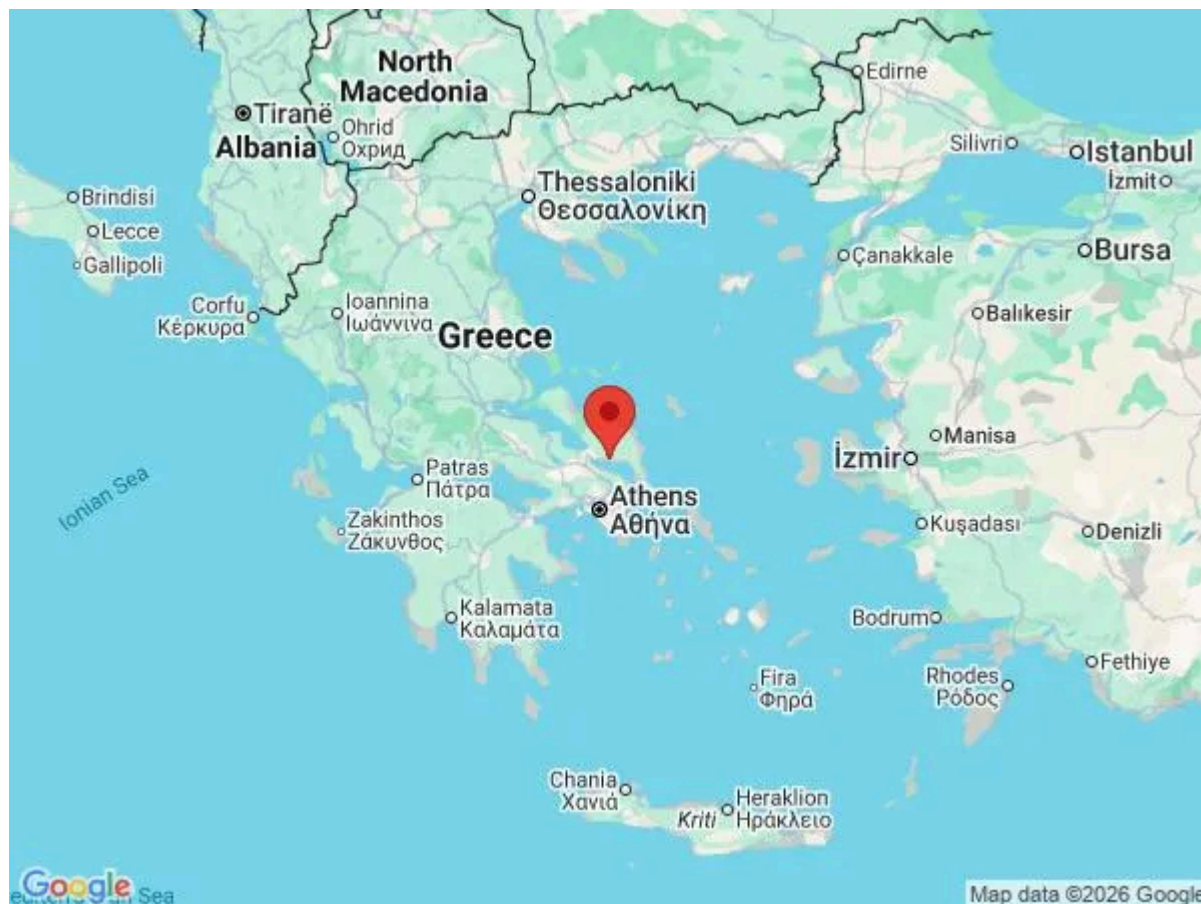
## Location & Local Information

Villa Kythera sits quietly along the coast of Eretria, one of Evia's most historically rich and picturesque towns. Just a short stroll or drive away, the town offers a relaxed yet vibrant atmosphere with everything you might need, bakeries for fresh morning pastries, traditional tavernas serving locally caught seafood, and quaint cafés ideal for watching the world go by. Eretria's sandy beaches are perfect for swimming, sunbathing, or enjoying water sports, while shaded promenades invite peaceful evening walks by the sea.

History lovers will appreciate the nearby Archaeological Museum and the ancient ruins of the old city, including mosaics, temples, and the famed ancient theatre. Local shops sell artisanal goods and regional delicacies, while regular ferries connect Eretria to the mainland, making day trips simple. The area is also known for its olive groves and pine-covered hills, ideal for hiking and cycling. Villa Kythera places you at the heart of it all, close to culture, nature, and warm Greek hospitality.

- **Security deposit:** There is no security deposit, but should there be any damage or loss caused by you or your guests during your stay you will be liable for the cost

- **Insurance:** Guests are required to be in possession of a valid insurance policy, which covers them for cancellations, personal belongings, personal liability and any accidental damage caused during their stay.

- **Internet access?:** The property has complimentary Wifi connection. It is good to note that the speed is dependent on local provider and technical issues may cause reduced speed or cut of service.
