Overview

Perfectly located to experience the timeless landscapes of both Les Alpilles and the Luberon, Piazza Pierre is a spacious three-bedroom holiday home welcoming up to six guests, complete with a private garden and inviting swimming pool.

Air-conditioned throughout, the interiors impress with a sense of space and character. A luminous open-plan living area seamlessly combines a comfortable lounge and elegant bar, with doors opening onto the terrace. This flows through to a generous dining space and a well-equipped kitchen, ideal for preparing convivial Provençal meals.

Upstairs, three well-sized bedrooms, including a master double with its own en suite bathroom, ensure restful nights. The flexible bedding configuration includes two king-size beds and two singles that can be joined to suit your needs. An additional shower room adds further convenience.

Outside, the pretty garden surrounds a saltwater swimming pool, complete with sun loungers and native Provençal planting. Unwind beneath the pergola with a chilled glass of Luberon AOC rosé or enjoy long al fresco feasts on the terrace, beside the Weber gas barbecue. Piazza Pierre is wonderfully suited to sociable living, both indoors and out.

The villa enjoys a superb location, with renowned destinations such as Cavaillon, Eygalières and Saint-Rémy-de-Provence just a short drive away, alongside the cultural gems of Avignon and Aix-en-Provence. Whether exploring hilltop villages, sampling local wines, or simply unwinding by the pool, Piazza Pierre offers a memorable base from which to savour the very best of Provence.

Location & Local Information

An ideal location in Provence, set between the rolling hills of Les Alpilles and the fertile plains of the Durance Valley, Plan-d'Orgon acts as a gateway to some of the region's most captivating sights.

Piazza Pierre enjoys an attractive setting in a residential neighbourhood with other houses, close to the village football and rugby fields and 600m from tennis courts. The main road that connects Cavaillon and Saint-Rémy-de-Provence is only 500m away and within 1.5km you can be on the D7 between Avignon and Aix-en-Provence. Just minutes away lies the historic village of Orgon (4.2km), perched against limestone cliffs and home to the impressive Notre-Dame de Beauregard chapel.

You are also well located for reaching the town of Cavaillon (5.5km), famed not only for its Roman heritage and 1st-century arch but also for its succulent summer melons, celebrated with a lively festival each July. Wander through its old town, potter around the bustling weekly market, visit the 12th-century cathedral and take in panoramic views from the Saint-Jacques hill.

Both hilltop Eygalières (9km) and artistic Saint-Rémy-de-Provence (16km) are quintessential Provence - think winding cobbled lanes, elegant stone façades and delightful weekly markets. Saint-Rémy, a muse to Van Gogh, is steeped in Roman history, with the ruins of Glanum providing a glimpse into the past. Nature lovers will relish the proximity to Les Alpilles Natural Regional Park, where olive groves and rocky crags form a stunning backdrop for hiking and picnics. The iconic village of Les Baux-de-Provence is around half an hour away.

A short journey north-east reveals the magic of L'Isle-sur-la-Sorgue (17km), renowned for its antique shops, canals and Sunday morning brocante, while Fontaine-de-Vaucluse (21km) offers a more tranquil escape, with the mysterious spring of the Sorgue River bubbling forth from a dramatic cliffside cave. Further into the Luberon, you'll find the picture-perfect hilltop villages of Gordes (25km),



Oppède le Vieux (18km), and Ménerbes (20km), each brimming with history, artistic spirit and panoramic views of orchards, vineyards, forest and idyllic Provençal scenery.

For a cultural day out, head to Avignon (26km), just over half an hour by car. This UNESCO-listed city dazzles with its majestic Palais des Papes, medieval bridge, and lively squares. In the other direction, fall in love with Aix-en-Provence (60km) and the landscapes of Mont Sainte-Victoire.
