Overview

Framed by sweeping sea views and the verdant landscapes of the French Riviera hinterland, Villa Tribu is a refined sanctuary where elegant design meets the ease of Mediterranean living. Tucked in a leafy enclave, this spacious villa embraces natural light and serene panoramas, creating an atmosphere that's both uplifting and indulgently calm.

Thoughtfully designed to host up to 14 guests, Villa Tribu unfolds across three generous levels. The heart of the home is the luminous living and dining space, where the eye is drawn through to the superb upper terrace for al-fresco dining overlooking the village and distant Mediterranean coast. The wonderfully equipped kitchen is modern and sleek whilst there is a TV lounge with Netflix for relaxing time away from the sun.

Six well-appointed en suite bedrooms offer flexibility and privacy, all with queen-size double beds, including a master suite with terrace. Practical touches such as air-conditioning throughout, a fitness room and daily housekeeping ensure a carefree stay.

Outside on the level below, the villa's sprawling south-facing grounds are an oasis of greenery, ideal for long afternoons by the swimming pool overlooking olive trees tumbling below. Guests can enjoy leisurely games of table tennis and pool or unwind in the hot tub.

Villa Tribu is perfectly positioned to explore the charms of the region. Just a short drive or walk along the hilly lanes, Cabris village offers delightful restaurants, while the perfume capital of Grasse lies only ten minutes by car. Golf and tennis are close at hand, and the glittering coast of Cannes is the perfect trip, close enough for a day of glamour, yet far enough to savour peaceful evenings in the hills.

Whether you're gathering with loved ones or seeking a stylish base to explore the Riviera and its hinterland, Villa Tribu invites you to settle into a slower rhythm, where every view is a delight and every detail designed for pleasure.

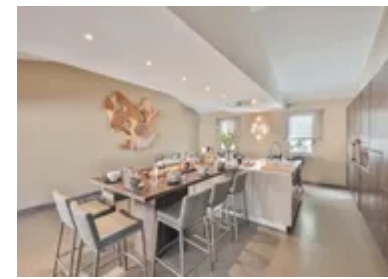
Interior & Grounds

Location & Local Information

Villa Tribu is perched above the beautiful village of Cabris, located in the French Riviera hinterland with panoramic views over the distant Côte d’Azur below.

It’s a very short drive (or leisurely walk) along the hilly lanes to Cabris where you can admire flower-filled cobbled lanes, stone houses with shutters and a small handful of restaurants where time seems to pause. A perfect blend of Provençal authenticity and understated elegance, Cabris makes an irresistible base for exploring the captivating hinterland.

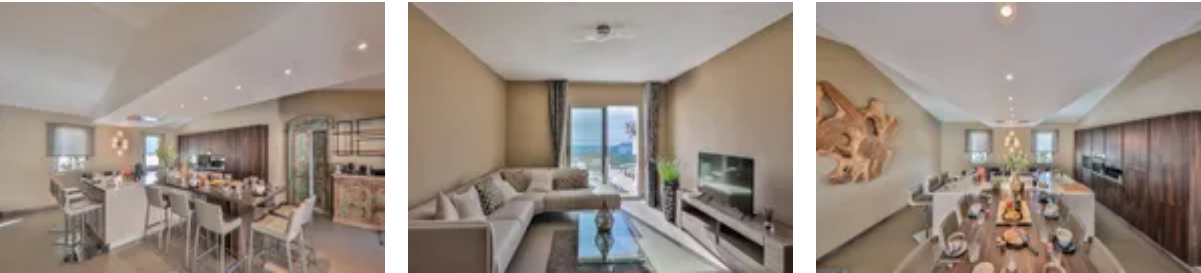
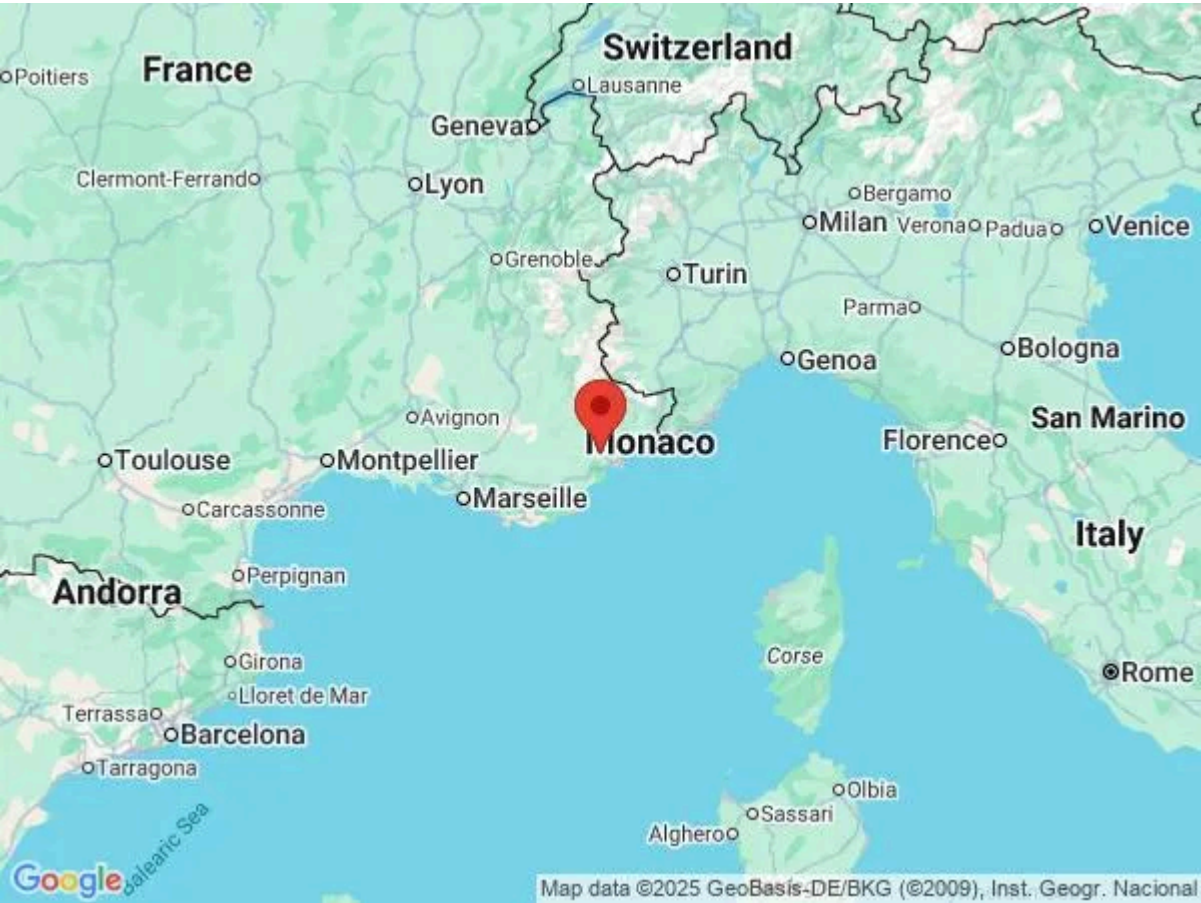
Just minutes away, the perfume capital Grasse (6km) delights with its historic perfumeries, Fragonard, Galimard, and Molinard, where visitors can take scent-making workshops or wander through jasmine-scented streets lined with medieval facades. Nearby, Valbonne (16km) and Mougins (17km) charm with fine restaurants and rich cultural heritage, including Mougins’ links to Picasso and its acclaimed Museum of Classical Art. Don’t miss Valbonne’s famous Friday morning Provençal market.

Nature lovers will be drawn to the azure waters of Lac de Saint-Cassien (20km), a serene spot for kayaking, paddleboarding or lakeside picnics beneath the shade of umbrella pines. To the west, the villages of the Pays de Fayence (Seillans, Callian, and Fayence for example) exude rustic charm, authenticity and glorious surrounding scenery.

For those craving a taste of the Riviera’s coastal glamour, the glitz of Cannes (23km) and the old-world elegance of Antibes (32km) lie around 45 minutes away. From Michelin-starred dining and designer shopping to coastal walks and sandy beaches, the French Riviera’s iconic allure is effortlessly accessible.
