Overview

Framed by olive groves and Provençal sunshine, La Petite Pierre is part of a beautifully restored 18th-century olive mill, offering an authentic escape in the heart of Les Alpilles. Set within a working olive estate, this charming three-level holiday home invites you to unwind in rural surroundings just five minutes from the traditional village of Mourières.

Inside, the air-conditioned house exudes character with exposed stone walls contrasting modern interiors and there's a warm, welcoming feel throughout. The open-plan ground floor offers space and convenience, where a stone-clad living area flows into a well-equipped kitchen-diner, ideal for relaxed family meals or sociable evenings with friends.

Upstairs, three simple yet pretty bedrooms are spread over two floors, reached via a spiral staircase. The first floor features an attractive double room with a king-size double bed and a family bathroom with. The top floor offers two further bedrooms, each with twin beds beneath the sloping ceilings and traditional wood beams.

The vast grounds offers space to dine al-fresco or simply admire the many olive trees. Following this, how about a lounge in the jacuzzi?

Ideally located between the villages of Mourières and Maussane-les-Alpilles, La Petite Pierre places you at the heart of one of southern France's most captivating regions. Explore hilltop towns, bustling markets, Roman ruins and vineyard trails, or venture further to Arles, Avignon or the Camargue.

Whether you're seeking rural moments beneath olive trees or days filled with discovery, La Petite Pierre offers an unforgettable base for exploring the magic of Les Alpilles.

Location & Local Information

In the heart of Les Alpilles Natural Regional Park, La Petite Pierre is part of an expansive olive estate set between the picturesque villages of Mouriès (3km) and Maussane-les-Alpilles (5km).

Surrounded by olive trees and wild garrigue, Mouriès proudly holds the title of France's olive oil capital. Its time-honoured mills, bustling weekly markets and traditional cafés offer a true taste of Provençal life at a gentler pace.

Just a short drive away, the delightful village of Maussane-les-Alpilles (5km) welcomes visitors with its charming square, popular restaurants and charming Thursday market. A little further, Le Paradou (6.5km) captivates with rustic stone buildings, leafy plane trees and the much-loved Bistrot du Paradou.

The spectacular hilltop village of Les Baux-de-Provence (8.5km) is a must-see, where dramatic ruins and panoramic views reveal the dramatic allure of Les Alpilles. This region is a haven for nature lovers, with limestone ridges, pine woods and olive groves criss-crossed by scenic trails ideal for hiking.

Not far away, Saint-Rémy-de-Provence (14km) offers a mix of heritage and modern flair, with restaurants, art galleries and ancient Roman remains. Meanwhile, Arles (29km) invites exploration of its Roman past and serves as a gateway to the raw beauty of the Camargue, with its salt flats, wild horses and flamingo-filled wetlands.

Further afield, fascinating day trips include the UNESCO-listed Pont du Gard (45km), historic Nîmes (50km), Avignon's grand Palais des Papes (34km) and the sophisticated town of Aix-en-Provence (63km). When it's time to unwind by the water, the sandy beaches of Fos-sur-Mer (35km) or the scenic lakefront of L'Étang de Berre in Martigues (42km) are both within easy reach.

Offering a harmonious blend of nature, history and Provençal authenticity, this location is an idyllic starting point for discovering the best of southern France.
