Overview

Among ancient olive groves and fragrant Mediterranean gardens, Casa Pietra Bianca sits quietly in the golden hills outside Noto, basking in the Sicilian sun. A hideaway with space to relax, the estate blends rustic stone architecture with generous open plan living and beautifully framed views across the countryside. The main house and two dependences offer six characterful bedrooms and six bathrooms, making it an ideal base for extended families or a group of friends sharing sunlit days and starlit dinners.

Inside, the interiors are warm and full of personality, handcrafted wood furniture, traditional tiled kitchens, vaulted ceilings and sunlight streaming through picture windows. Outdoors, life flows easily from shaded terraces to the expansive garden, where a long swimming pool stretches across the lawn and sun loungers catch the afternoon breeze. Long tables beckon for lazy lunches, and a barbecue area sets the tone for relaxed evenings under the olive trees. With room to gather and places to retreat, this is Sicilian living at its most genuine.

Casa Pietra Bianca enjoys a serene location just outside Noto, a town renowned for its golden Baroque architecture and laid-back charm. You're perfectly positioned to explore southeast Sicily's captivating coastline and cultural gems. A short drive takes you to Noto's historic centre, where winding streets reveal gelaterias, elegant piazzas and majestic churches carved from honey-hued stone.

Nearby beaches such as Lido di Noto and Calamosche offer soft sand and gentle waters, ideal for a day by the sea. The Vendicari Nature Reserve is also close, with peaceful trails, birdwatching spots and quiet coves. For food lovers, this region is a haven, local markets brim with sun-ripened produce, and trattorias serve fresh seafood and local wines under vine-covered pergolas.
