

Domaine De Nerige

Overview

Beyond its long private drive, Domaine de Nérige reveals itself as a masterpiece of refined French country living, set in eighteen acres of rolling vineyards, fields and woodland. The former wine estate has been fully renovated to an exceptional standard, preserving its original character while introducing contemporary comfort at every turn. From the moment you step onto the large terrace, the views sweep down the valley towards the distant Pyrénées, a constant reminder of the beauty that surrounds you.

Inside, the décor blends authentic period features with thoughtful design. Beamed ceilings, marble fireplaces and colourful Languedoc floor tiles sit alongside elegant furnishings and carefully chosen artworks. At the heart of the home, a vast kitchen is equipped for both family gatherings and professional catering, complete with dual ovens, multiple sinks, coffee station and separate bar area. Elegant reception rooms invite evenings by the fire or convivial dinners in the formal dining area.

Seven bedrooms accommodate up to fourteen guests, with four air-conditioned suites offering private seating areas and libraries. Six of the bedrooms boast high-specification en suite bath or showers, ensuring privacy and comfort for most guests.

The vast south-facing terrace is perfect for leisurely breakfasts or al fresco suppers, while the 11-metre private pool beckons on the level below for cooling dips under the Mediterranean sun. Games of table tennis and pétanque can fill languid afternoons, while younger guests enjoy the football pitch, cricket net or swing ball. The estate's sprawling grounds offer both open spaces for activity and shaded corners for quiet retreat.

The location offers the best of Languedoc. Just half an hour from the medieval citadel of Carcassonne, with its winding streets, restaurants and summer festivals, and 10km from the lively square of Limoux, famed for its sparkling wine, the estate sits at the heart of a region rich in culture and gastronomy. Horse riding, vineyard tours, canal-side cycling and visits to ancient abbeys are all within easy reach, while the golden sands of the Mediterranean are perfect for a superb day out.

Whether gathering for a special celebration, enjoying an intergenerational family holiday or simply escaping the rush of everyday life, Domaine de Nérige offers an elegant setting where each day feels timeless.

Main Floor (some steps)

Location & Local Information

Located within a 18-acre estate of vines, woodland and open fields, Domaine de Nérige offers a stunning escape with sweeping vistas stretching all the way to the snow-capped Pyrénées.

Just 30 minutes south of the UNESCO-listed city of Carcassonne and a mere 10km from the beautiful market town of Limoux, this idyllic retreat blends privacy and easy access to some of the region's most celebrated sights. Whether you're seeking sunny days in the garden or adventures in the surrounding countryside, the location is nothing short of exceptional. For those keen to keep active, a riding stable is only four minutes away, while tennis enthusiasts can enjoy courts in both Saint-Martin-de-Villéréglan and nearby Cépie.

Limoux (10km) is a delight to explore, with its charming central square, traditional restaurants, bustling cafés, a bakery and a weekly market offering irresistible local delicacies. It's also home to Blanquette de Limoux, a sparkling wine said to pre-date Champagne, offering superb taste at a fraction of the price.

A little further afield, Carcassonne (25km) promises a wealth of experiences – from atmospheric medieval shows and summer festivals to Michelin-quality dining and lively street cafés. Golfers can take advantage of the 18-hole course with club hire and driving range, while nature lovers will relish the endless walking and hiking trails that criss-cross the surrounding countryside. The nearby Canal du Midi is perfect for cycling or simply lingering over a long, lazy lunch at one of its waterside auberges.

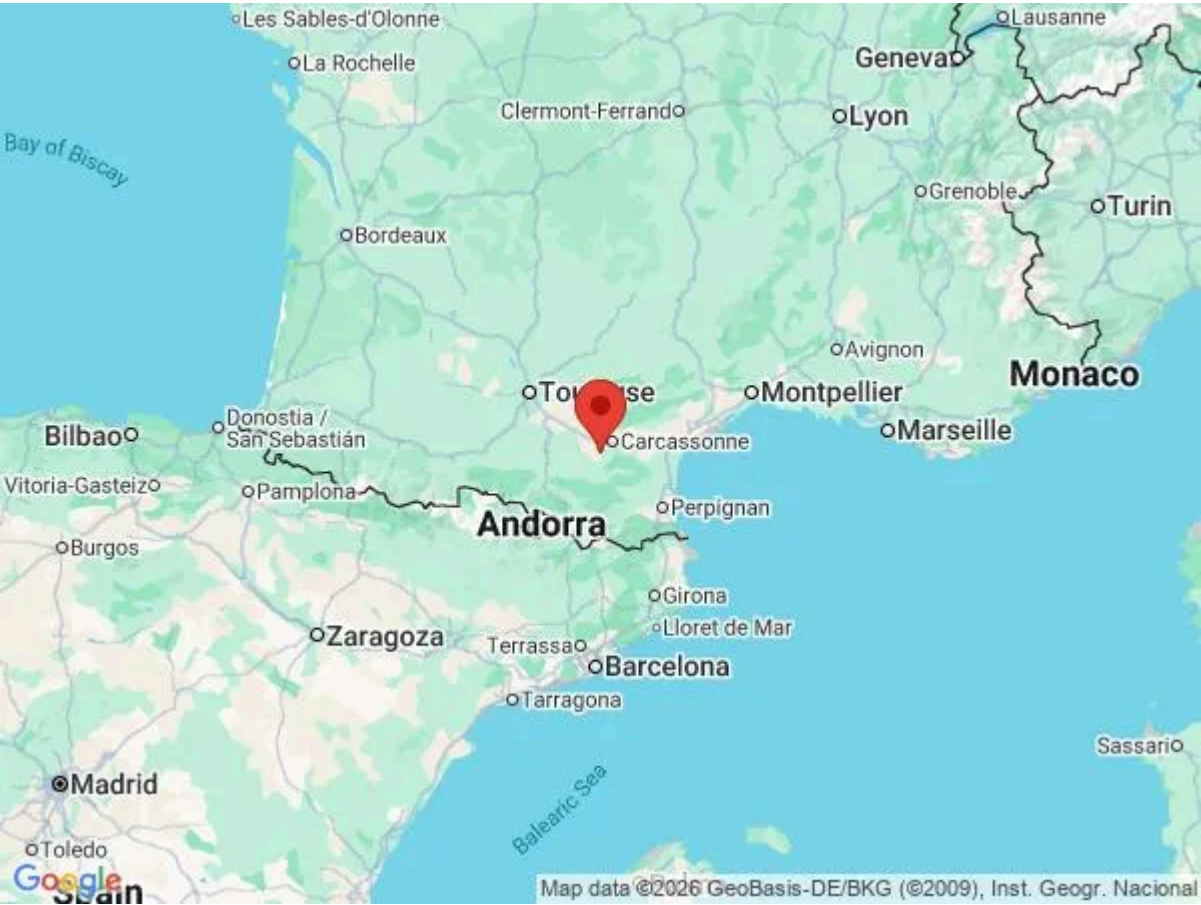
History and wine connoisseurs will be equally captivated. Explore Saint-Hilaire, just 16km away, with its ancient abbey linked to the Cathar trail, or tour the vineyards of the prestigious Minervois and Corbières appellations. The area's gastronomic reputation is well-earned – even celebrated chef John Burton Race filmed his acclaimed "French Leave" series here.

For a day by the sea, the golden sands of Narbonne-Plage are less than 90 minutes away, while the Spanish border lies just over 2 hours by car for a cross-cultural adventure.

With such a rich blend of natural beauty, cultural treasures and indulgent pleasures, Domaine de Nérige is the perfect base from which to experience the very best of southern France.
