Location & Local Information

In the historic walled town of Richelieu, Maison Richelieu offers guests a privileged base to explore one of the most enchanting corners of the Loire Valley. With its elegant boulevards, symmetrical architecture and leafy parks, Richelieu itself is a delight - steeped in history yet full of local life. Just a few minutes' walk from the house you'll find traditional boulangeries, bustling cafés, a small supermarket, local artisan shops and a twice-weekly market bursting with fresh produce and regional treats.

The picturesque town of Chinon is only 20 minutes away, renowned for its rich medieval heritage, atmospheric wine bars and the dramatic fortress that crowns the hilltop. Meander through its narrow lanes, hire a canoe to drift gently down the Vienne River or enjoy wine tastings at renowned local domaines. Keen cyclists note that there is a dedicated cycling path from Richelieu all the way to Chinon.

A little further afield, Saumur (49km) awaits, a captivating town on the Loire known for its beautiful château, riverside views, equestrian heritage and vibrant summer festivals. Its café terraces and cobbled streets make it a perfect day out – make sure you try some of Saumur's famous sparkling white wine.

Nature lovers and outdoor enthusiasts will relish the wider region's wealth of open-air pursuits. Cycle routes along the Loire River weave past vineyards, sleepy villages and fairytale castles. Canoeing on the wide, slow-moving waters is equally peaceful and easily arranged on the Loire or Vienne rivers. Golfers will enjoy the relaxed 9-hole course at Saumur or the scenic 18-hole course at Golf de Loudun-Fontevraud (38km), both offering an enjoyable challenge in striking surroundings.

Culture and history abound in this region, with many of the Loire Valley's most celebrated châteaux within easy reach. Highlights include the turreted Château d'Ussé (34km), said to have inspired Sleeping Beauty, and the hauntingly beautiful Royal Abbey of Fontevraud (36km), resting place of Eleanor of Aquitaine, Henry II and Richard the Lionheart. Each site brings a rich tapestry of stories, art and architecture to uncover.

Whether you're drawn to the fine wines, the grand history or the relaxed elegance of town life, Maison Richelieu places it all within effortless reach - an ideal base for soaking up the charm and splendour of this classic French landscape.
