

# Le Chateau De La Loire

## Overview

From its stately position overlooking the glistening waters of the Loire, Le Château de La Loire is a rare expression of artistic refinement and comfort, where history and hospitality converge in effortless harmony. Just 15 minutes from the storybook town of Saumur, this distinguished château blends timeless architecture with modern indulgence, offering a high-level of service.

Within its grand stone walls, seven elegant bedrooms await, each featuring king-size beds and ensuite bathrooms. High ceilings, soft natural light and exquisite furnishings create a refined, yet inviting atmosphere. Days unfold in bright reception rooms with river views, a contemporary kitchen warmed by an open hearth and quiet corners designed for relaxation with family or friends.

A short walk across the grounds, the private 10-metre heated pool invites leisurely afternoons beneath the French sun whilst the poolside wellness pavilion features a soothing spa, sauna and indoor swimming pool. Daily housekeeping and a breakfast service, paired with 24-hour concierge, elevate the overall magical experience. For additional guests, ask about rates for the château's 2-bedroom tower that is also available on request.

Set near the confluence of the Loire and Vienne, the château enjoys a prime location just moments from two of France's 'Plus Beaux Villages', Candes-Saint-Martin and Montsoreau. Riverside Saumur, with its atmospheric streets, bustling markets and wine bars, is also nearby and perfect for a day of exploring.

The region brims with cultural and natural treasures, from the fairy-tale towers of Château d'Ussé to the royal tombs at Fontevraud Abbey. Outdoor pursuits abound, including cycling, canoeing, horse riding and golf, all surrounded by the gentle rhythm of the Loire.

Whether gathering with friends and family or planning an unforgettable occasion, Le Château de La Loire offers a setting where French elegance meets effortless living.

# Location & Local Information

Perched above the river near the confluence of the Loire and Vienne, Le Château de La Loire offers guests a gateway to the beauty of the Loire Valley. Located just outside the picturesque village of Candes-Saint-Martin and a mere 2-minute drive from Montsoreau, this elegant château is perfectly placed for those looking to immerse themselves in the region's cultural richness and natural splendour.

Candes-Saint-Martin is one of France's most beautiful villages, with cobbled streets and a gentle pace of life. This former fishing village is full of character with traditional boats moored along the river and glorious views from higher vantage points. The village's famous church dates back to the 4th century and is now listed as a historic monument.

Candes-Saint-Martin is also home to Street Art Parc (next to the château and part of the same wider estate), a striking open-air museum that hosts contemporary installations, summer events and occasional live performances, blending the old-world setting with vibrant modern creativity.

Cycling enthusiasts will love the Loire à Vélo trail that winds along the riverbanks, offering an idyllic way to explore the countryside. Furthermore, look out for traditional river boats that glide along the Loire and there are plenty of canoeing opportunities across the region.

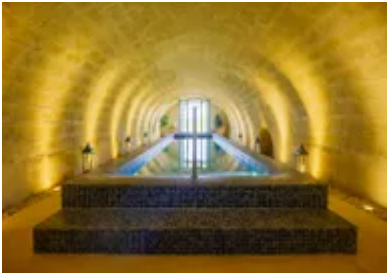
Meanwhile, Saumur, just 15 minutes away, offers bustling markets, a grand château with panoramic views and a renowned equestrian school with spectacular summer shows. Make sure you try some of the historic town's famous sparkling wine and visit its surrounding vineyards.

History lovers are spoilt for choice with nearby landmarks like the impressive Fontevraud Abbey (5km), final resting place of Henry II and Eleanor of Aquitaine, and the cliffside fortress of Chinon (17.5km), where the Vienne River meets medieval charm. Further afield, yet still easily accessible, are the grand châteaux of the Loire – from the romantic Château d'Ussé (20km), said to have inspired Sleeping Beauty, to the refined elegance of those near the historic city of Tours (60km).

Whether you're indulging in the region's gastronomy, discovering its royal heritage or simply cycling beside the river, Le Château de La Loire offers a refined and memorable base from which to savour all the magic of the Loire Valley.
