Location & Local Information

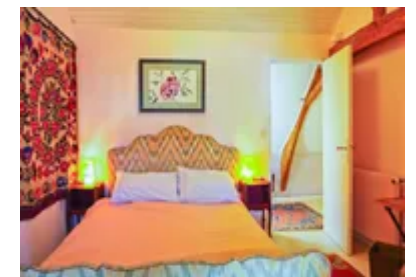
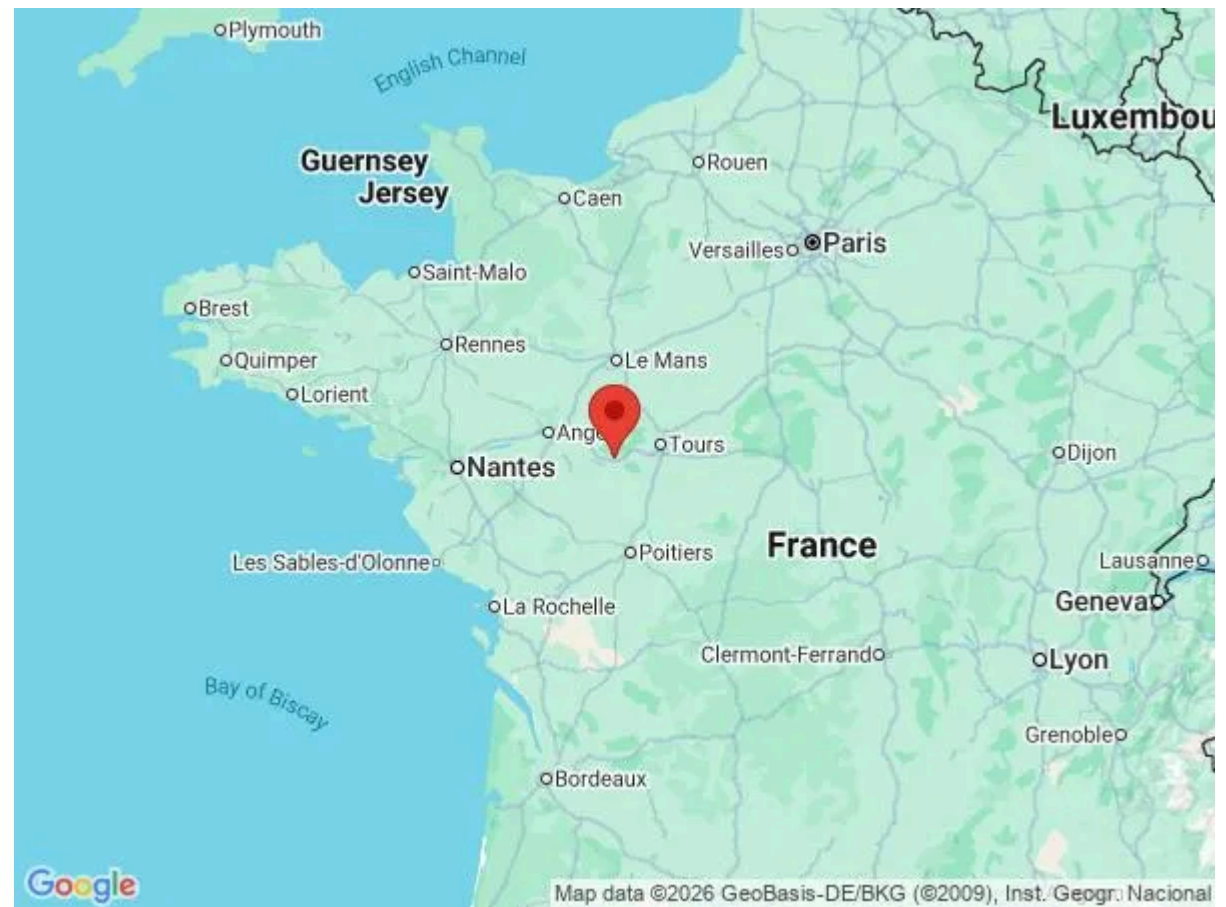
Les Averries is set within the stunning Loire nature park, part of a UNESCO World Heritage site, just outside the charming town of Bourgueil. With all amenities only a short walk or five-minute drive away, this is the perfect base to immerse yourself in the beauty and heritage of the Loire Valley. The area is a paradise for outdoor enthusiasts, offering mountain biking, horse riding, canoeing, golf, and even hot air ballooning, alongside walks through vineyards and riverside paths.

History and culture lovers will be spoiled for choice, with world-renowned landmarks close by. Bourgueil Abbey, dating back to the 10th century, is steeped in heritage, while the nearby Abbey of Fontevraud is the resting place of the Plantagenet kings, including Richard the Lionheart. Within a 20-mile radius, you can also explore the fairy-tale châteaux of Chinon, Ussé, Azay-le-Rideau, Langeais, and Saumur. For family fun, the futuristic theme park Futuroscope in Poitiers is just an hour away.

To complete the experience, indulge in the local flavours. Bourgueil and Chinon produce some of the finest wines of the region, and the weekly market held under the town's historic halles is a delight for food lovers, filled with fresh produce, local cheeses, and artisan treats. Whether seeking relaxation, adventure, or cultural discovery, Les Averries places it all within easy reach.
