

# La Villa Lana

Region: Languedoc Sleeps: 8

## Overview

Framed by the distant peaks of the Pyrénées, La Villa Lana offers a contemporary escape on the edge of the traditional village of Verzeille. Set within 2.5 acres of landscaped gardens and woodland, this spacious four-bedroom holiday home combines modern comfort with the relaxed charm of southern France. A large sun terrace runs the length of the villa, inviting long, lingering meals in the open air as the light shifts across the hills.

Inside, the generous living-dining area flows seamlessly to the outdoors, creating a home designed for family gatherings and easy entertaining. Two king-size doubles and two twin rooms comfortably accommodate up to 8 guests across two floors alongside two bathrooms. The well-equipped kitchen makes cooking a pleasure, yet with a summer kitchen and drinks bar by the pool, the temptation to dine al-fresco is irresistible.

Reached via steps, the pool terrace is a private haven of its own, where a 10-metre by 5-metre pool glistens in the sun, bordered by lavender, plants and a pretty terrace for restful afternoons. Families can enjoy a game of boules or seek shade in the woodland with far-reaching views. Electric gates and outdoor lighting offer both seclusion and peace of mind.

Verzeille is a short stroll away for morning bread and local wine, while Carcassonne, with its UNESCO-listed medieval cité and vibrant town centre, lies just 14km north. The surrounding Limoux vineyards offer exceptional tasting experiences, and Mediterranean beaches are around an hour's drive. For more active days, cycling routes, white-water rafting in the Aude gorges and the scenic fairways of Carcassonne Golf Course await.

Whether sharing leisurely meals under the pergola, cooling off in the pool after a morning exploring Carcassonne, or simply gazing at the vine-draped hills, La Villa Lana sets the stage for a holiday of warmth, comfort and discovery in one of France's most captivating regions.

# Location & Local Information

Located on the edge of the charming village of Verzeille, just 15 minutes south of Carcassonne, La Villa Lana offers a gorgeous base for exploring one of France's most captivating regions. Framed by the distant Pyrénées, this is a location that effortlessly blends authentic French charm with world-class attractions. From your doorstep, you can stroll into the heart of the village (for bread and wine) or set out to discover the surrounding landscapes, brimming with history, culture and fine wine.

Wine lovers will be delighted to find themselves in the heart of the Limoux appellation, famed for its sparkling Blanquette de Limoux, believed to be the oldest sparkling wine in the world. Visit vineyards across the region for private tastings or head further afield to the Minervois and Corbières areas to savour rich reds and crisp rosés in wineries. The relaxed pace of life here pairs beautifully with long, leisurely afternoons sampling local vintages beneath vine-covered terraces.

A short drive takes you to the legendary walled Cité de Carcassonne (14km) – a UNESCO World Heritage Site whose fairy-tale turrets and cobbled streets promise a journey back in time. Combine your visit with a stroll, cycle ride or boat trip along the tree-lined Canal du Midi and soak in the beauty of this historic waterway.

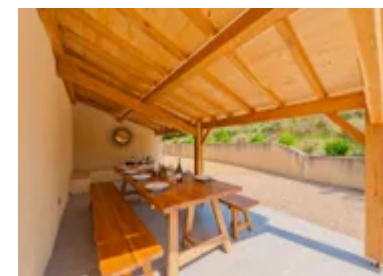
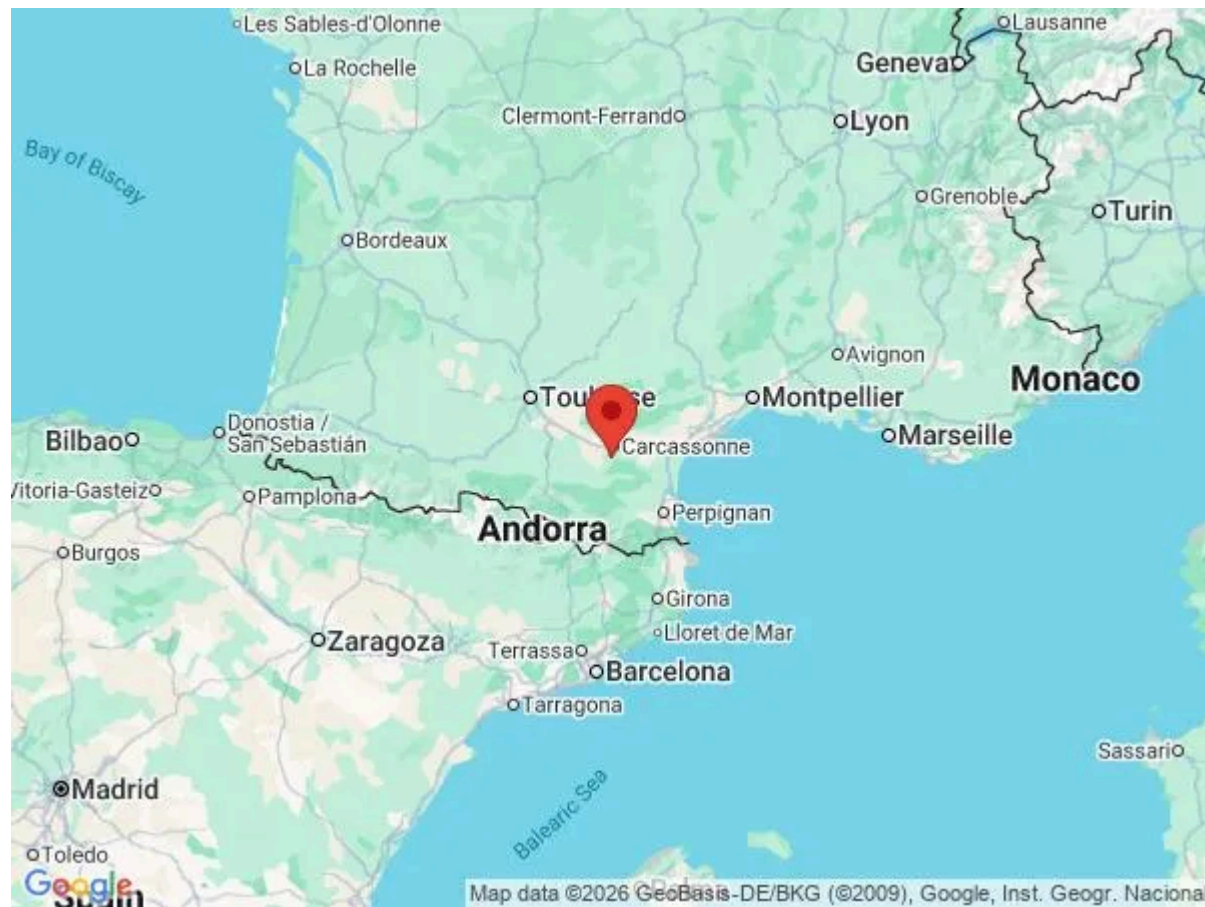
Further afield, discover the medieval market town of Mirepoix (52km), with its arched square, colourful timber-framed houses and Monday morning market, or wander through Fanjeaux (33km), steeped in Cathar history and perched high with sweeping valley views. Even closer, Limoux (16.5km) itself is a joy to explore, especially on market day.

For those seeking a more active adventure, the region offers endless possibilities – from cycling routes that have hosted stages of the Tour de France to white-water rafting through the dramatic gorges near Alet-les-Bains (25km). Golf enthusiasts will find Carcassonne's excellent 18-hole course just 10 minutes away, while the glorious sands of the Mediterranean coast lie in around an hour's drive.

Whether your passion is history, wine, outdoor pursuits or simply soaking up the southern French sunshine, La Villa Lana places it all within effortless reach.
