Overview

In the heart of the Minervois village of Paraza, Maison de la Mairie invites guests to experience the warmth and character of a fully renovated family home. With pretty green shutters, original architectural details and relaxed interiors, this is a place where modern comfort meets traditional village life.

Spanning three floors, the house offers flexible accommodation with four bedrooms and three bathrooms. Mornings begin with coffee around the central island or a gentle breakfast beneath the vine-covered terrace. Later, cool off in the courtyard swimming pool, unwind on a sun lounger or dine alfresco beside the gas barbecue. Indoors, high-speed fibre Wi-Fi and Smart TVs provide entertainment and there's even table football to keeps younger guests occupied.

Just 250m from the house, a village shop and café provide fresh croissants and other essentials. A short walk leads to the banks of the Canal du Midi, where tree-lined towpaths, waterside cafés and cycling trails invite hours of easy adventure. Nearby Ventenac offers a bakery and renowned wine outlet, while the market town of Narbonne, just 19km away, is a hub of culture, cuisine and Mediterranean energy. A little further afield, the Languedoc coastline and Carcassonne are both wonderful day trips.

With its authentic charm, courtyard swimming pool and village location, Maison de la Mairie is an ideal base for relaxed holidays in the South of France.

Location & Local Information

In the heart of Paraza, Maison de la Mairie enjoys a prime spot in this small Minervois village, a short walk from the banks of the Canal du Midi, almost equidistant between Béziers and Carcassonne and less than 40km from Narbonne Plage.

Just 250m from the house, a shop and café provides essentials, from fresh croissants to local snacks, whilst there are a couple of other cafes near the Canal du Midi, only a 5-minute walk away. This picturesque waterway, a UNESCO World Heritage Site, brings a gentle rhythm to village life, where colourful boats drift past and towpaths invite leisurely strolls or cycle rides.

From your doorstep, you can explore the rich surroundings by bike or within scenic drives. Ventenac-en-Minervois (3km) is a traditional canal-side village with a bakery, post office, impressive wine outlet and two waterside restaurants perfect for a relaxed lunch. For more amenities and a taste of local life, nearby Saint-Nazaire-d'Aude (6.6km) offers bike hire (ask about bike delivery to your door) whilst the surrounding villages of Roubia (4km), Ginestas (6km) and Canet (4.5km) offer traditional eateries and laid-back cafés, ideal for soaking in the region's slow and relaxing pace.

Those with a taste for adventure can head to Minerve (21km), a dramatically perched medieval village that once sheltered the Cathars and now offers spectacular views and wine-tasting opportunities. Tuesdays are perfect for a visit to the nearby market in Olonzac (12km), where stalls brim with seasonal produce, cheeses and local delicacies. A day trip to Narbonne (19km) offers vibrant markets, Roman ruins, chic boutiques and a wide choice of restaurants — or make a day of it with a picnic by the Mediterranean at Narbonne Plage (37km).

Carcassonne (45km) and Béziers (41km), both under an hour's drive, provide striking contrasts: Carcassonne with its fairy-tale medieval citadel and buzzing summer festivals, and Béziers with its elegant architecture and celebrated wine heritage. Whether you're exploring historic towns, cycling along the Canal du Midi or simply relaxing with a glass of local wine, Maison de la Mairie places you at the heart of it all.
