

Loft Du Vigneron

Region: Languedoc Sleeps: 6

Overview

In the heart of the historic Minervois wine region, Loft du Vigneron blends traditional heritage with contemporary comfort. Once the home of a local wine-maker, this beautifully renovated property offers a refined place to stay in the charming town of Rieux-Minervois. The first-floor terrace is an idyllic spot to relax, while the walled courtyard below reveals a gorgeous swimming pool, perfect for cooling dips on long summer afternoons.

Across one upper floor, the living spaces are elegant and welcoming. The fully equipped kitchen makes home dining a pleasure, while the comfortable lounge invites relaxed evenings with Wi-Fi and internet TV. This level also features three beautiful bedrooms, each with its own ensuite bathroom, with two opening directly onto the upper terrace. From breakfast on the terrace to evenings chatting with good local wine, every moment here feels unhurried and restorative.

Rieux-Minervois itself is steeped in history, dating back to the 11th century. Its rare 12th-century heptagonal church is an architectural treasure, and twice-weekly markets fill the streets with colour and local flavour. All daily needs are within a very short walk, with cafés, restaurants and shops close at hand.

Carcassonne, just 20 minutes away by car, enchants with its UNESCO-listed medieval citadel, while the surrounding region unfolds with vineyards, Cathar castles and the tree-lined waters of the Canal du Midi. Further afield, the golden beaches of Narbonne-Plage lie within an hour's drive, or venture to the drama of the Pyrenees or the charm of Catalan Spain – Girona is just over two hours by car or follow the winding roads towards artistic Cadaqués.

Whether savouring fine wines, exploring medieval hilltop towns or simply unwinding by the pool, Loft du Vigneron offers an authentic and elegant base to discover the very best of southern France.

Location & Local Information

In the heart of the Minervois wine region, Loft du Vigneron offers a beautiful base in the historic village of Rieux-Minervois.

Encircled by rolling vineyards and framed by the distant peaks of the Montagnes Noires, the village blends authenticity with easy access to some of southern France's most interesting sights. Carcassonne (27km), with its fairy-tale turrets and UNESCO-listed ramparts, lies just 30 minutes away, while the golden sands of Narbonne-Plage beckon an hour to the east.

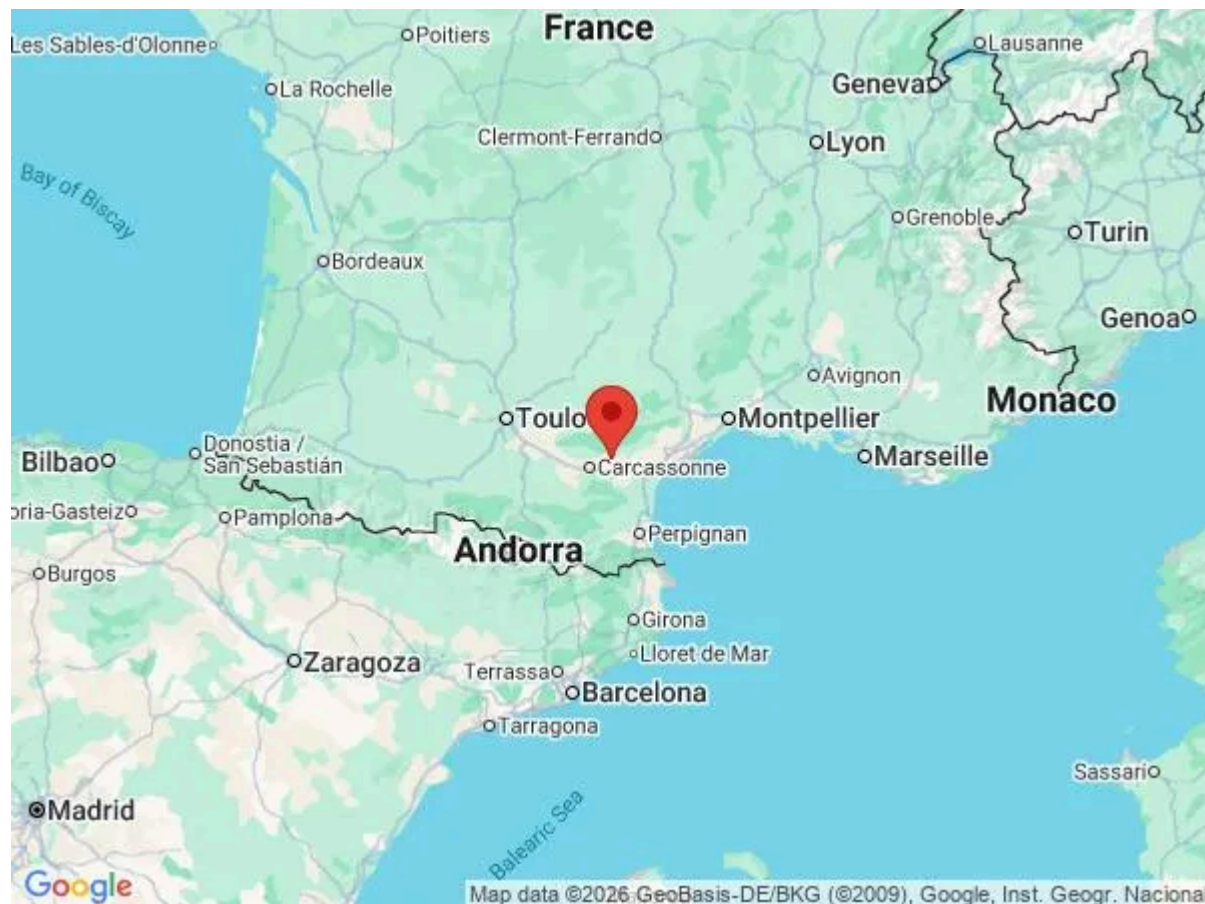
From your doorstep, it's a short stroll along the main road into the village centre, home to traditional shops, café bars and restaurants. Twice a week, the market brings fresh local produce to tempt the senses. Rich in history, Rieux-Minervois dates back to the 11th century and is home to a rare 12th-century heptagonal church, its intricate columns crafted by the renowned Master of Cabestany.

The village lies along one of the ancient pilgrimage routes to Santiago de Compostela, adding a layer of cultural depth to its timeless charm. The local tourist office is an excellent resource for planning adventures, from gentle walks among the vines to boating along the nearby Canal du Midi or cycling into the foothills of the Corbières. Wine lovers will be spoilt for choice, with vineyards in every direction offering tastings of the Minervois' celebrated reds and rosés.

Beyond the village, history and natural beauty abound. Explore the dramatic Cathar castles of Lastours (48km), perched high above the valleys, or lose yourself in the cobbled streets of Minerve (21km) and Lagrasse (33km), both officially listed among France's most beautiful villages. For nature enthusiasts, the surrounding landscapes provide a rich tapestry of hiking trails, river gorges and scenic picnic spots.
