Two welcoming lounges, one with a television and Wi-Fi access, offer space to gather or simply unwind. Upstairs, five well-appointed bedrooms provide a restful escape, including three with en-suite bathrooms and two sharing a stylish Jack and Jill shower room, ideal for families or friends travelling together.

Beyond the traditional charm of the interiors, the grounds offer endless appeal. Mature trees create dappled shade across the lawns, while the dining terrace sets the stage for leisurely meals. The private pool is a highlight, framed by soft grass and loungers, with views stretching toward the distant Pyrénées.

Set in a tiny hamlet, this is a great position for exploring many highlights of southern France. Local amenities including a supermarket and restaurants can be found just five minutes away in Alzonne, while the enchanting city of Carcassonne, with its medieval citadel, summer festivals and atmospheric café culture, is a short 20-minute drive.

Enjoy cycle rides or boat trips along the Canal du Midi, discover superb Languedoc vineyards and visit the vibrant market towns of Revel and Limoux. The enchanting landscapes of the Montagne Noire await further north or you may simply prefer relaxing canalside lunches in Castelnaudary, the birthplace of cassoulet, less than half an hour away.

Whether gathering with loved ones or enjoying a countryside escape, Domaine de Belzons promises a stay full of timeless charm and the simple pleasures of southern France.

Set in a tiny countryside hamlet close to Sainte-Eulalie in the Aude department, Domaine de Belzons offers a beautiful retreat with easy access to many highlights of southern France, only 20 minutes from the enchanting city of Carcassonne and its international airport.

Everyday essentials are within easy reach in nearby Alzonne (3km), just five minutes by car, where you'll find a supermarket, local restaurants and village atmosphere.

Yet a short drive further transports you to Carcassonne (18km), a city famed for its UNESCO-listed medieval cité. Within its ancient ramparts, discover cobbled streets, lively café terraces and superb dining, alongside year-round festivals, medieval jousts, concerts and spectacular sound-and-light shows that bring the castle's storied past to life. On the other side of the town, close to the Canal du Midi, soak up the ambience in La Bastide Saint-Louis with its vibrant market, restaurants and wine bars.


For other memorable day trips, the surrounding region offers experiences to suit every taste. Head west to Castelnaudary (24km), the birthplace of cassoulet, and enjoy a leisurely stroll or cycle ride by the historic Canal du Midi. Wine enthusiasts will be spoiled for choice with numerous local vineyards offering tastings of the region's acclaimed vintages, including Limoux's sparkling white wine just half an hour away. Meanwhile, the market town of Revel (39km) delights visitors with its celebrated Saturday morning market, one of the most authentic and atmospheric in the region.

Nature lovers and outdoor adventurers will also find much to explore. To the north, the Montagne Noire reveals picturesque villages and sweeping landscapes, perfect for scenic drives and hikes. For summer days, the beautiful Bassin de Saint-Ferréol (35km) invites you to swim, sail or enjoy a tranquil lakeside walk amid nature.

Whether your passions lie in history, gastronomy or the great outdoors, Domaine de Belzons provides a superb setting to experience it all.
