

Le Malardier

Overview

Le Malardier is a handsome, detached country home offering rustic comfort in a wonderfully secluded setting. Formerly featured in both The Sunday Times and The Telegraph's Style Magazine, the property has been thoughtfully renovated to retain its character while delivering modern ease. Savour breakfast on the terrace or relax by the pool as the warm Dordogne sun arcs overhead.

Set within private grounds, this expansive family home unfolds across three floors, where original beams, stone walls and graceful proportions create a sense of timeless warmth. Five bedrooms, each with their own character, are spread between the main house and a charming poolside garden annexe, whilst there are four bathrooms (two en suite).

The private, heated pool is the centrepiece of the garden, with a dedicated sun deck, loungers and a summer house for escaping from the sun, poolside reading or evening aperitifs. Meanwhile, guests can play table tennis, boules and badminton on summer days, then gather by the outdoor dining space for barbecues – a relaxed rhythm of life that only the French countryside can offer.

Located just a 10-minute drive from the market town of Ribérac, Le Malardier sits at the heart of a region rich in charm and culture. The nearby village of Verteillac offers local cafés, bakeries and restaurants, while river beaches at Aubeterre and Saint-Aulaye promise warm afternoons swimming and canoeing. Explore Brantôme's canals, stroll the markets at Chalais or Bergerac and enjoy wine tasting and château visits throughout the wider region.

Whether hosting a laid-back summer gathering or seeking a peaceful countryside retreat, Le Malardier is a gem of northern Dordogne.

Location & Local Information

In the beautiful countryside near the tiny village of Bertric-Burée, Le Malardier offers an idyllic base for exploring the Dordogne and Charente regions of southwest France.

Surrounded by gently rolling farmland and sunflower fields, the property is just 10km from the bustling market town of Ribérac, yet feels a world apart in its rural setting. Nearby Verteillac (5km) provides your daily essentials – a traditional bakery, butcher, grocery store and a handful of cafés and restaurants where you can unwind after a day’s adventure. Even closer, there is a bakery just 2km away.

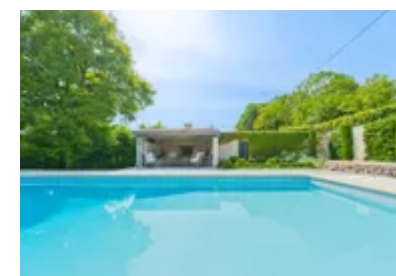
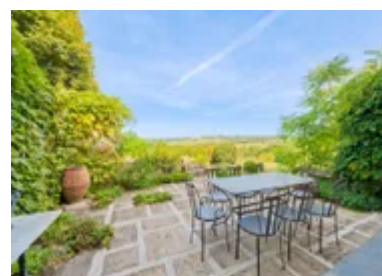
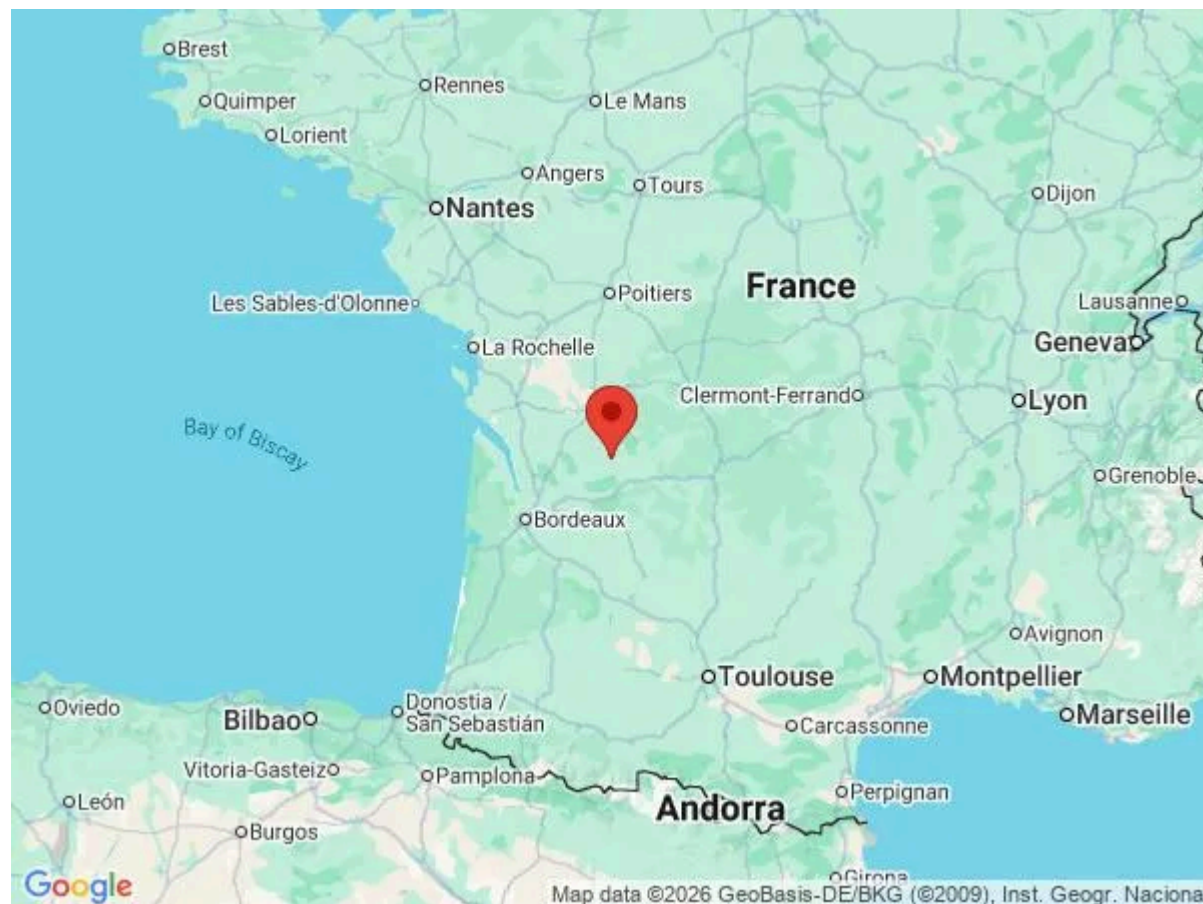
Ribérac is a delight to explore, particularly on Friday mornings when the town bursts into life for its renowned market – one of the largest in the area. From fresh produce and local cheeses to artisan crafts and clothing, it’s a lively affair not to be missed. Tennis enthusiasts will find public courts here too, open from early till late with excellent value weekly passes. Further south, Le Grand Étang de la Jemaye (25km) offers a family-friendly day out with a lakeside beach, summer supervised swimming, canoe hire, playground and cafes.

For scenic river days, the Dronne delivers. Head to Aubeterre-sur-Dronne (23km) or Saint-Aulaye (28km) for pretty river beaches and charming villages. Aubeterre, officially one of Les Plus Beaux Villages de France, enchants with its white-stone houses, monolithic church and a Sunday farmers’ market. Château fans should visit nearby Chalais, where the château looms above the town, or continue to the abbey in Brantôme en Périgord (33km) and the majestic Château de Bourdeilles (23km), with canoeing options all along the Dronne.

When you’re ready to roam further afield, a wealth of historic towns awaits. Périgueux (40km) charms with Roman ruins, museums, and the striking Cathédrale Saint-Front, while Bergerac (60km) and Saint-Émilion (78km) offer wine lovers and history buffs plenty to savour. Venture north-west to Cognac (86km) for distillery tours and boat trips along the Charente, or explore the cultural flair and ramparts of Angoulême (51km). Whether you’re craving culture, cuisine or calm, Le Malardier places you in the heart of it all.
