

Le Chambarru

Overview

Within the heart of the picturesque village of Blauzac, Le Chambarru rises behind stone walls as a refined 16th-century manor house, its beautiful façade a quiet witness to centuries of southern French charm. Lovingly restored by its French and Belgian owners, this heritage home balances noble character with stylish comfort, offering a wonderful escape just moments from local village life.

Inside, the atmosphere is generous and warmly inviting. Original beams, a grand fireplace and open-plan living spaces reflect its storied past, while high-quality furnishings and thoughtful details make each room feel effortlessly welcoming. A fully equipped kitchen opens directly to the shaded terrace, where long lunches stretch into lazy afternoons and expansive views. Upstairs, a large landing opens to a character library with billiard table, while three well-appointed bedrooms and two bathrooms accommodate up to 6 guests with ease.

Outside, the garden feels like a world of its own featuring mature olive trees, lawn and a gleaming 10-metre pool framed by a stone sun terrace. Whether relaxing on a lounger or gazing out towards Uzès and distant Mont Ventoux on the horizon, guests are treated to a setting that feels classic and timeless.

Just a very short stroll from the front door brings you to Blauzac's café-bar, bakery, grocer and restaurant - everything you need within arm's reach. The vibrant town of Uzès is under ten minutes away by car, offering a wealth of boutique shops, café terraces and restaurants, not to mention its famed twice-weekly market on Place aux Herbes beneath the plane trees. For days out, the Pont du Gard is just 25 minutes away, while the chic beaches of the Mediterranean coast are easily reached in over an hour.

Whether you are seeking relaxation or an authentic base for exploring Provence and the Gard, Le Chambarru promises a stay that's full of character, comfort and charm.

Location & Local Information

Located in the charming village of Blauzac, Le Chambarru offers a picture-perfect base for exploring one of southern France's most culturally rich and naturally beautiful corners. This characterful village is home to a café-bar and restaurant, a grocery and bakery store, newsagent and post office, all just a short stroll away.

Around ten minutes away, the elegant town of Uzès (8km) offers a broader array of boutique shops, bustling café terraces, gourmet restaurants and a famed Saturday market regarded as one of the best in the South of France. It's such a picturesque town to stroll around with its winding lanes and café terraces beneath the plane trees on the main square, Place aux Herbes.

The wider region is a delight for lovers of nature and heritage alike. The nearby Pont du Gard, a UNESCO-listed Roman aqueduct, is just 25 minutes away and stands as one of France's most iconic landmarks. Wine enthusiasts will find themselves spoilt with tastings available across the surrounding vineyards and the neighbouring Rhône Valley, where generations of winemaking tradition meet sun-soaked terroir.

Day trips are effortlessly rewarding from Le Chambarru. Nîmes is just 20km away, offering its spectacular Roman amphitheatre, pedestrianised old town and tree-lined boulevards dotted with cafés and restaurants. Arles (54km), with its atmospheric arena, vibrant art scene and Van Gogh legacy, makes for a fascinating visit, especially on market days. Avignon (42km) too is within easy reach, perfect for exploring the majestic Pope's Palace and the famous Pont d'Avignon.

For those longing for the sea, the stylish Mediterranean beach resort of Le Grau-du-Roi (68km) can be reached in just over an hour, while the wilder sands of Saintes-Maries-de-la-Mer (75km) in the Camargue lie just a little further afield. Between beach days, vineyard visits and city adventures, the local area also offers golf and equestrian centres for guests seeking more active pursuits.
