Overview

Rising proudly above the Aveyron valley, Château du Pic de Rigaud is a masterfully restored 19th-century residence set within ten acres of private grounds. From its elevated position, this refined country retreat commands sweeping views over the treetops to the medieval turrets of Najac's original 13th-century château. Thoughtfully renovated to an exceptional standard, the château pairs period elegance with contemporary comfort, creating a warm, light-filled space for families and groups to gather in style.

Inside, the living areas are generous and welcoming. A traditional kitchen with twin ovens opens onto a dining space, while two spacious lounges invite slow afternoons with a book or film. Upstairs, five individually styled bedrooms sleep up to 9 guests, including two ensuite bedrooms with super king-size beds and a large family bathroom, all arranged to offer privacy and ease. UK television with apple TV, a DVD and Wi-Fi throughout ensure all the practical touches are covered.

Outdoors, the property comes into its own. Wide lawns and mature trees offer seclusion, whilst the château's heated swimming pool can be found in the heart of the grounds beside elegant cypress trees and sun loungers. Long lunches under the covered poolside dining area are the order of the day, with a barbecue and fridge freezer, or simply sit back and admire the views that stretch endlessly across the rolling countryside.

Just a short drive or 1km stroll leads to Najac's pretty village centre, where stone-fronted cafés, a bakery and summer night markets provide a taste of local life. Canoeing and kayaking on the Aveyron River are just minutes away, while horse riding, hiking and cycling routes radiate from the surrounding hills. A little further afield, explore the winding lanes of Saint-Antonin-Noble-Val or stock up at the vibrant markets of Villefranche-de-Rouergue.

Whether you're planning a relaxed family escape or a holiday with friends, Château du Pic de Rigaud offers a refined setting with space to unwind, breathe deep and soak up the slow rhythm of southern France.

Set amidst the rolling hills of the Aveyron countryside, just 1km from the postcard-worthy village of Najac, Château du Pic de Rigaud enjoys an idyllic yet accessible location in one of south-west France's most captivating regions. From its elevated setting, you're perfectly placed to soak in the beautiful scenery while enjoying rural living, all within easy reach of local life.

The charming village of Najac (1km) offers all the essentials for a relaxed stay: café-bars, restaurants, a bakery and a small grocery store, not to mention the delightful Sunday market and Wednesday night market during the height of the summer, where locals gather in the square to savour regional delicacies with live music and local wines. Climb to the incredible Château de Najac for the most incredible views. No wonder Najac is classified as one of France's 'Plus Beaux Villages'.

Just 5km away, La Fouillade provides further conveniences including a supermarket, pharmacy, and newsagent, while larger shops and services can be found in the bastide town of Villefranche-de-Rouergue, 22km away.

Nature lovers and thrill-seekers alike will relish the wealth of outdoor pursuits on offer. Canoeing and kayaking can be enjoyed just five minutes from the château, while horse-riding is also close by. For walkers and cyclists, the wild beauty of the Gorges de l'Aveyron offers countless trails through dramatic limestone cliffs and ancient woodland, with charming medieval villages such as Penne (38km) and Bruniquel (45km) dotting the river's path. For a taste of regional culture, don't miss a visit to Saint-Antonin-Noble-Val (31km), famed for its vibrant market and artisan crafts, also loved for its incredible watersports and adventurous canoeing opportunities.

Head further south to discover the Tarn's celebrated Golden Triangle – from the hilltop vistas of Cordes-sur-Ciel (30km) to the wine town of Gaillac (53km) and the UNESCO-listed city of Albi (54km), each brimming with historical character and gastronomic flair.

Whether savouring local produce in Najac, exploring medieval market towns or adventuring through river valleys, Château du Pic de Rigaud is your gateway to the timeless beauty and culture of the Aveyron and beyond.
