Overview

Maison Bourg Calès is an enchanting 18th-century village home that perfectly blends rustic character with understated comfort. First built in 1750 and thoughtfully restored in 2009, this classic French cottage welcomes guests with exposed beams, stone walls and a warm, welcoming ambience that instantly feels like home. Hear the church bells chime as you enjoy your morning coffee with a glimpse of the Dordogne River.

Inside, the home unfolds across two floors, with a relaxed and practical layout ideal for families or groups of friends. On the ground floor, the living and dining areas are bright and homely, with everything you need for long, convivial meals or quiet evenings in. The adjoining kitchen is fully equipped, and there's a bathroom on this level for added convenience. Upstairs, three inviting bedrooms (two king-size doubles and a twin) are accompanied by two well-appointed bathrooms. Outside, a converted barn houses a fourth bedroom with its own open shower room, offering extra privacy and a lovely sense of independence.

The enclosed garden is charming where a shaded terrace, barbecue and pretty pool area offer plenty of space to unwind. The private pool, with a contra-flow swimming current, is a highlight, perfect for refreshing dips on hot afternoons or simply lounging by the water with a good book.

Maison Bourg Calès sits in an enviable position between Bergerac and Sarlat-la-Canéda, with the market town of Lalinde just five minutes away by car. This is a region rich in history, gastronomy and natural beauty. Wander the medieval lanes of Sarlat, paddle down the Dordogne by canoe, explore prehistoric cave art at Lascaux or visit Château de Monbazillac for a taste of the region's renowned sweet wine.

Whether you're seeking long summer days by the pool, a cultural escape through centuries-old towns or simply the charm of rustic living, Maison Bourg Calès offers a quintessential Dordogne experience.

Location & Local Information

Located in the small village of Calès, Maison Bourg Calès enjoys a privileged position close to many highlights of the Dordogne region, between Bergerac and Sarlat-la-Canéda.

Less than a 10-minute drive away lies Lalinde, a bustling market town with all essential amenities, including a bakery, supermarket and welcoming cafés. Venture a little further to Bergerac (29km), once a vital wine-trading port, where timber-framed buildings line cobbled lanes, and the riverside invites leisurely boat rides or scenic train tours. Here, visitors can sample regional wines, browse boutique shops and enjoy the buzz of café terraces spilling onto sunny squares.

The surrounding region is dotted with captivating bastide villages. Spend a day wandering the medieval streets of Monpazier (24km) or Issigeac (25km), each offering a window into the Dordogne's rich past. Limeuil (12km), where the Dordogne and Vézère rivers meet, is another gem, perfect for riverside picnics or exploring its panoramic gardens. For a truly memorable meal, head to nearby Trémolat (5km), home to Michelin-starred dining and scenic countryside walks with sweeping views over the river.

For day trips, Sarlat-la-Canéda, just 45km away, is a must. This jewel of the Périgord Noir brims with golden stone buildings, Gothic spires and one of the region's finest weekly markets, famed for its truffles and seasonal produce. Closer still, Les Eyzies, just half an hour by car, is a world centre for prehistoric heritage, home to fascinating caves and museums showcasing early human history.

From canoeing and golf to hot air ballooning, horse riding and château visits (including the impressive Château Lanquais or the elegant Château de Monbazillac), Maison Bourg Calès offers effortless access to an unforgettable array of cultural, culinary and outdoor adventures in the heart of the Dordogne.
