

Domaine Massot

Overview

Framed by two hectares of garden lawns and woodland, Domaine Massot is a grand yet welcoming 19th-century estate just a short drive from the vibrant town of Béziers.

Originally established in 1816 and lovingly rebuilt at the turn of the century in the style of an Italian villa, this former winemaker's domaine invites guests into a world where tradition and charm meet beneath the southern French sun.

Across its three expansive floors, this home offers a collection of beautifully proportioned rooms, where original architectural features blend effortlessly with family-friendly comforts. The charming kitchen features a range oven, while a breakfast room and formal dining space make mealtimes a pleasure. The main salon flows directly onto the outdoor dining terrace and pool area, creating a seamless link between indoor and alfresco living. With Wi-Fi throughout and generous sleeping arrangements spread across seven bedrooms, Domaine Massot offers space to unwind and reconnect, sleeping up to 14 guests.

Outside, the estate is a paradise for both relaxation and play. The vast lawned garden is perfect for afternoon games, while a completely private 13-metre pool encourages lazy swims and lively rounds of pool volleyball. Badminton, table tennis and open countryside access provide plenty to fill sunny days, while a handpicked selection of good local wines on arrival sets a welcoming tone from the moment you arrive.

Perfectly placed just 2.5km from the village of Maureilhan, it's an easy drive for morning croissants and fresh bread. The Mediterranean coastline is within a 20 to 30-minute drive, offering sandy beaches at Vendres, Sérignan, and Valras-Plage, while charming towns like Capestang and the historic Canal du Midi are close by. With Béziers, Carcassonne and Montpellier all wonderful days out, this is an ideal base for exploring the cultural and culinary delights of southern France.

Whether enjoying long lunches on the terrace or exploring nearby markets, vineyards and beaches, Domaine Massot offers a timeless setting for unforgettable moments.

Location & Local Information

Domaine Massot enjoys a rural setting just a 5-minute drive from the traditional village of Maureilhan. Surrounded by the rolling landscapes of the Hérault countryside, this elegant estate is perfectly positioned for guests seeking rich local discovery. From charming local markets and the Canal du Midi to Mediterranean beaches, the region offers an enticing blend of cultural heritage and natural beauty.

Maureilhan (2.5km) itself provides essential amenities, including a bakery and small grocery shop. For broader shopping and a taste of city life, Béziers (9km) offers hypermarkets, boutiques and a thriving restaurant scene. The nearby canal-side town of Capestang, under fifteen minutes from the domaine, adds further charm with its bustling square, weekly market and relaxed waterside eateries.


The celebrated Canal du Midi meanders gently through the area, offering picturesque walks and cycle routes between Béziers, Colombiers, Capestang and beyond. Highlights include the remarkable Étang de Montady (7km), a vast, circular wetland visible from the hilltop, and the historic Tunnel de Malpas (8km), the first canal tunnel of its kind in Europe. These peaceful towpaths and engineering marvels are perfect for slow-paced explorations of the local landscape.

Wine lovers are in their element here, with numerous domaines and family-run vineyards offering tastings just a short drive from the property. The region is renowned for its bold reds and refreshing rosés, and many producers welcome guests for informal tours and direct purchases. Whether you're a casual enthusiast or a seasoned connoisseur, this area invites you to savour the best of southern French viticulture.

When the coast calls, the golden sands of Vendres (20km), Sérignan (22km) and Valras-Plage (22km) are within easy reach. These classic Mediterranean beaches offer swimming, beachfront restaurants and water-based fun for all ages. With such variety on the doorstep, Domaine Massot offers an exceptional base for experiencing the very best of the Languedoc.
