

# Mas Saint Cernin

Region: Dordogne Sleeps: 12

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## Overview

Beyond a rolling sweep of mown lawns and ancient stone walls, Mas Saint-Cernin rests serenely amidst a beautiful two-hectare estate. This sensitively restored farmhouse and its charming pigeonnier offer a quintessentially French getaway for extended families or a group of friends seeking space and character, only a 5-minute drive from Issigeac, one of France's 'Plus Beaux Villages'.

The main house and the pigeonnier sit opposite one another, 20 metres apart, each with its own lovely dining terrace. On the other side of the estate, days unfold around the generous 13-metre swimming pool, completely private and framed by a large sun terrace with loungers for soaking up the southern warmth.

Inside the main house, a soaring open-plan living and dining area brings rustic elegance to life with its exposed stone walls and double-height ceilings. The farmhouse kitchen is equipped for long, lazy meals, while four bedrooms and three bathrooms offer comfortable privacy.

The pigeonnier, a traditional tower lovingly renovated, is a delightful addition with its own kitchen-diner, relaxed sitting area and two pretty bedrooms. Thoughtfully appointed with UK satellite TV, Wi-Fi and other modern touches throughout, both properties combine authentic French character with everyday comfort.

Guests can wander the vast gardens, dine al-fresco on the stone terraces or sip a quiet glass of local wine as evening nears. With generous grounds to roam, and cosy interiors for cooler evenings, Mas Saint-Cernin invites you to slow down and savour each moment.

Located on the border of the Dordogne and Lot-et-Garonne, this holiday abode is perfectly positioned for visiting bastide villages, market towns and local vineyards. Fall in love with nearby Issigeac, brimming with bakeries, cafés, restaurants and its renowned Sunday market. Heading north, Bergerac offers gastronomic restaurants, river trips and medieval charm less than 20 minutes by car.

Whether pottering around some of France's prettiest villages, canoeing along the Dordogne or simply soaking up the delightful surroundings of your holiday home, Mas Saint-Cernin offers a restful setting in one of the region's most charming corners.

# Location & Local Information

Part of a beautiful countryside estate, Mas Saint-Cernin enjoys a superb location on the border between Dordogne and Lot-et-Garonne, just a 20-minute drive south-east of Bergerac.

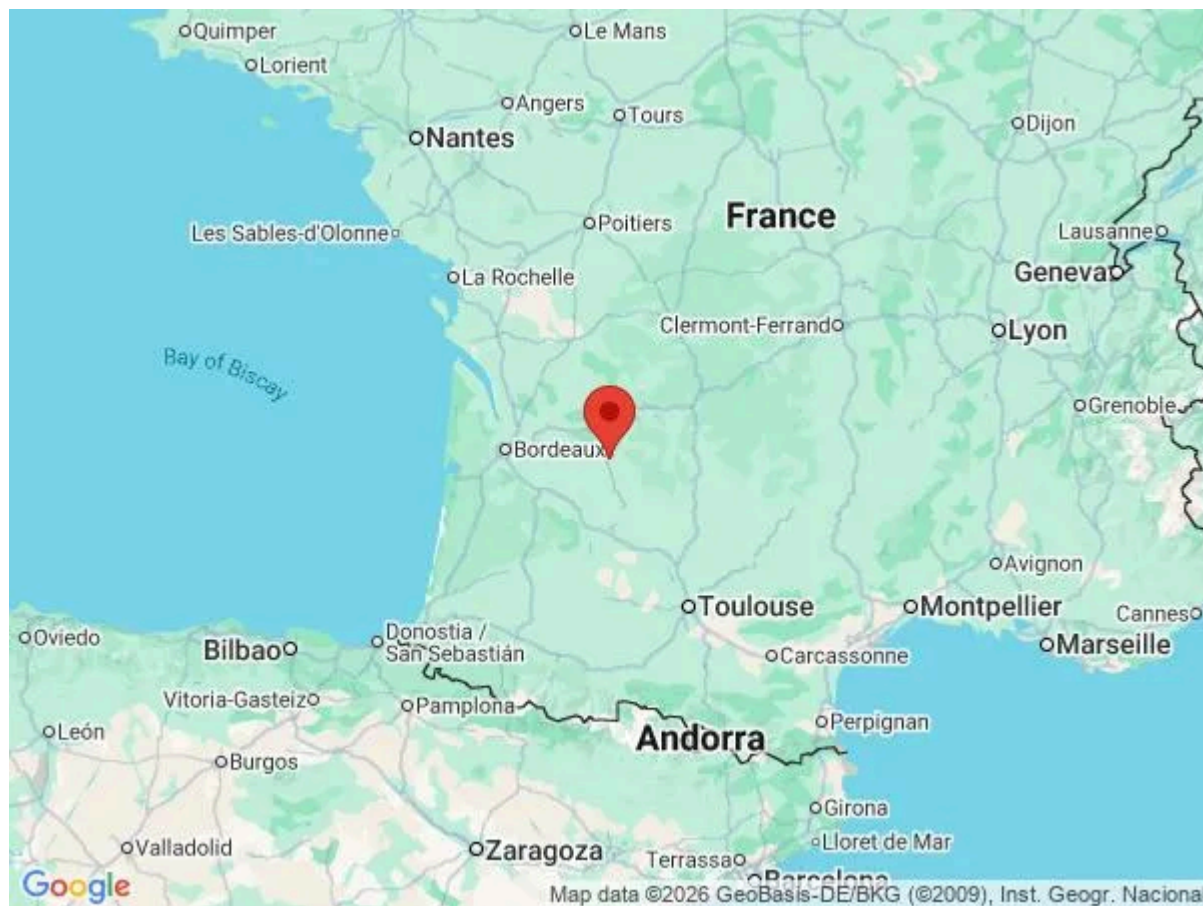
Only 5.5km by car, Issigeac is one of France's "plus beaux villages", renowned for its medieval charm and thriving Sunday morning market. Here, you'll find everything from fresh bread and croissants at the local bakeries to leisurely lunches at traditional café-bars. It's a gorgeous village to explore and it's wonderful to be so close.

A little further afield, Villeréal (21km) and Castillonès (15km) both provide further choice with bustling weekly markets, restaurants and all essential amenities. Castillonès in particular is home to Les Remparts, a restaurant praised for its exceptional cuisine. Each village showcases the unique character of the area with timber-framed houses, shaded squares and a laid-back rhythm of life that defines this idyllic region.

This part of southwestern France is a paradise for lovers of local culture and gastronomy. Wine tasting is a must across the vineyards of the Périgord Pourpre, with the celebrated Château de Monbazillac (9km) offering panoramic views and exquisite dessert wines. Bergerac itself, only 13km from the house, is a charming riverside town with opportunities for canoeing, river cruises and cultural excursions.

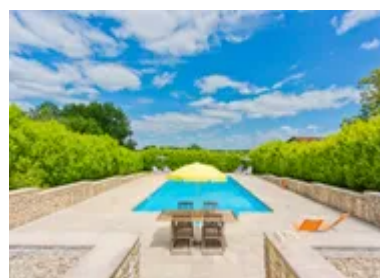
Venture a little further and you'll discover the bastide towns of Monpazier (32km) and Monflanquin (34km), rich in medieval history and brimming with artisan boutiques, traditional eateries and local markets.

Meanwhile, tennis, golf, horse riding and scenic walking trails are all readily accessible nearby, while many villages host atmospheric night markets during the summer months, perfect for sampling regional wines and local produce under the stars.
