

Montaillac

Overview

Set amid the gentle landscapes of the northern Lot-et-Garonne, close to the Dordogne and Gironde border, Montaillac is a beautifully restored country home that captures the timeless charm of rural France with every stone, shutter and rural view – you may even be fortunate enough to stay when summer sunflowers are in rotation.

Inside, original stone arches and exposed beams frame spacious living areas designed for sociable gatherings and relaxed moments alike. There are two generous sitting rooms, one with a fireplace and the other centred around a wood-burning stove. The farmhouse-style kitchen is fully equipped and leads directly to the garden terrace, while the atmospheric dining room invites candlelit dinners that stretch late into the evening. Each of the four ensuite bedrooms upstairs offers a restful sanctuary, three with super-king or twin options, the fourth with a four-poster double bed.

Outside, the setting is glorious. A wide lawn rolls gently away from the house, fringed by trees and open farmland. The private, heated pool sparkles in the sun, flanked by a spacious terrace with loungers and a shaded terrace complete with barbecue. Whether you're basking in the sunshine, enjoying a leisurely lunch or watching the sky soften at dusk, every corner of Montaillac feels designed for lingering.

Around a 15-minute drive from both Eymet and Duras, Montaillac offers easy access to the region's celebrated food markets, vineyards and hilltop towns. Local bakeries and shops are just a short drive away, while day trips to Bergerac, Saint-Émilion or even the Atlantic coast promise rich cultural excursions. For lovers of food, wine, and slow living, this part of south-west France is a dream.

Whether you're gathering with family or sharing a special stay with friends, Montaillac promises a restorative holiday in the heart of the French countryside.

Location & Local Information

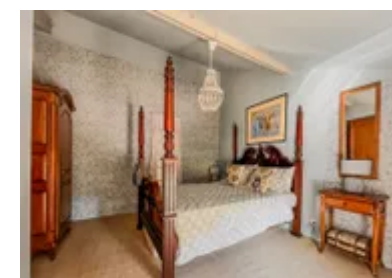
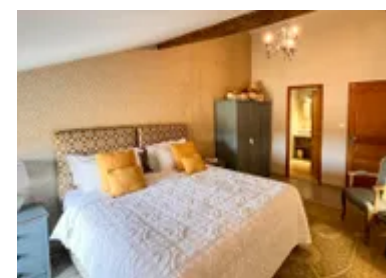
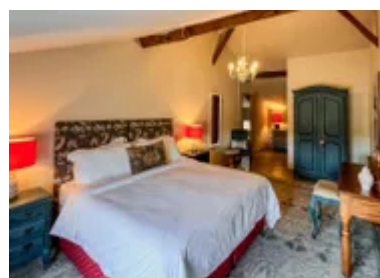
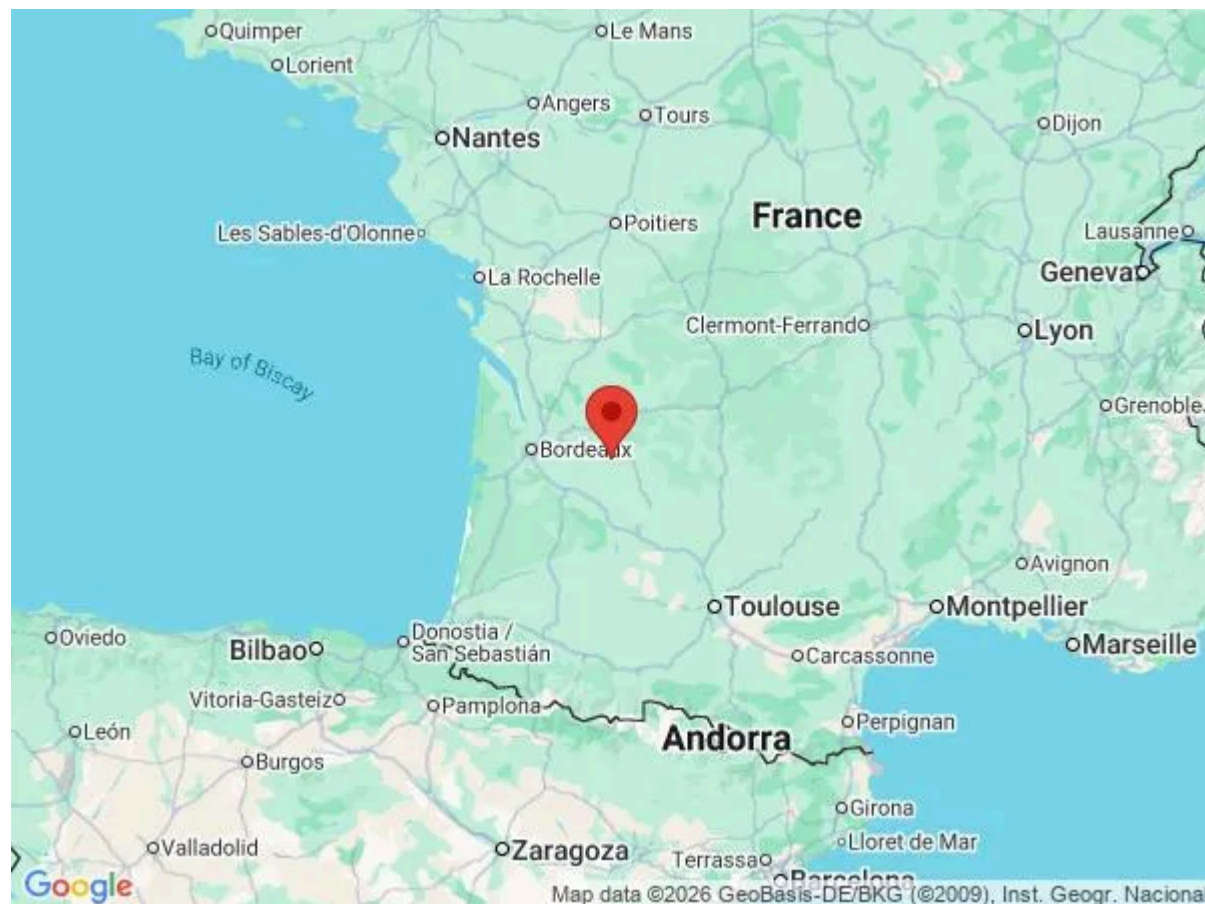
Set in the picturesque countryside of south-west France, Montailac enjoys a prime location where the Lot-et-Garonne, Dordogne and Gironde regions meet, offering easy access to charming towns, rivers and renowned vineyards. Surrounded by farmland, the house sits along a quiet country road, with seasonal views of sunflowers in summer.

A local shop, bakery and pizzeria are just 4km away, while an excellent French restaurant is within walking distance (800m). The riverside town of Sainte-Foy-la-Grande (15km) offers a large Saturday market and wider amenities, while Bergerac, around 40 minutes away, is perfect for exploring its old town, restaurants and river activities. Canoeing is also available nearby.

The bastide towns of Eymet and Duras (both around 14km) offer lively markets and historic charm. Wine lovers can enjoy tastings across Bergerac, Monbazillac and even Saint-Émilion. With its central setting, Montailac is an ideal base for discovering the best of south-west France.
