This enchanting 350-year-old former presbytery rests amid two hectares of countryside, its generous lawns, shady courtyard and fruit trees setting the tone for long, leisurely days in the sun. Beyond the gated entrance, discover the private heated pool edged by soft grass and loungers and a huge summer kitchen with pizza oven for effortless outdoor dining.

Inside, the house is effortlessly comfortable yet full of character. The Chalon kitchen is a cook's dream, outfitted with a Lacanche range, Quooker and breakfast table perfect for morning coffees or fruit picked straight from the garden. There's space to gather in the dining room with its piano, or relax in the lounge with its grand stone fireplace. A separate TV room and games area with table football, Wii console and UK satellite channels, offers the perfect escape for younger guests.

Upstairs, six individual bedrooms accommodate up to 12 guests, each dressed with Egyptian cotton linens and wild silk duvets. Four new bathrooms ensure privacy and comfort, while a balcony off the main bedroom invites quiet moments.

Ideal for families or groups of friends, Le Presbytere De Saint Paul offers a relaxed holiday setting with every comfort taken care of. Two hammocks swing in the breeze, mountain bikes are on hand to explore and services such as housekeeping, catering, babysitting and massages can be arranged to elevate your stay.

Location & Local Information

Le Presbytere De Saint Paul is located in the Lot-et-Garonne countryside, almost equidistant between Cancon and Monflanquin. Surrounded by rolling fields and woodland, the setting is idyllic and within easy reach of some of the region's most enchanting bastide towns.

Just 10km away lies Monflanquin, a 13th-century hilltop village classified among Les Plus Beaux Villages de France. Its cobbled lanes and arcaded square are lined with cafés, bakeries and boutiques, while panoramic views stretch across the gentle Lot-et-Garonne landscape. Visit on a Thursday morning to experience its traditional street market in full swing.

Even closer, a short drive also brings you to Cancon (4km), where you'll find a tennis court, a small supermarket and a charming village atmosphere, or to Casseneuil (14km) and Villeneuve-sur-Lot (18km), both brimming with local character, medieval architecture and lively riverside scenes near the Lot River.

Food lovers will be in their element here, with nearby restaurants serving up regional delights like confit de canard and truffle-infused dishes. The area is dotted with farmers' markets and brocantes throughout the year, perfect for picking up local delicacies or a vintage treasure.

For those who wish to explore further, the beautifully preserved bastide towns of Monpazier (30km) and Issigeac (27km) are easily reached by car and offer a wealth of heritage, artisan shops and scenic cafés. Golf enthusiasts can enjoy a round at Castelnaud golf club just 7.5km away, while active guests will find plenty of opportunities for walking, cycling and tennis in the surrounding area.

A day trip to Bergerac is not to be missed. This riverside town, just 45 minutes away, boasts a picturesque harbour, half-timbered buildings and a storied winemaking tradition. Sample local vintages at nearby vineyards, take a leisurely boat ride on the Dordogne or hop aboard the miniature train for a relaxed tour of the old town's architectural gems.

Whether you're seeking gastronomic delights, cultural excursions or simply a peaceful retreat in the French countryside, Le Presbytere De Saint Paul is ideally positioned to offer it all.
