

Maison L'Eveque

Overview

This contemporary villa in the charming village of Nézignan-l'Évêque offers a sun-soaked escape just moments from one of the Languedoc's most celebrated towns. The Mediterranean courtyard and swimming pool are made for long, languid afternoons and restful evenings under the stars.

Inside, the villa unfolds over two spacious levels, with a seamless flow between indoor and outdoor living. The ground floor welcomes you with a bright, open-plan layout, with a stunning kitchen and central island alongside a beautiful living room and dining area opening straight out to the poolside terrace and garden courtyard.

Sleeping up to 6 guests, a ground-floor double bedroom with an ensuite and direct access to the poolside terrace offers a gorgeous space to retreat. Upstairs, two additional ensuite bedrooms provide stylish accommodation, each with air-conditioning.

Beyond the villa, the location invites slow exploration. A five-minute walk brings you to the heart of Nézignan-l'Évêque, where morning coffees, warm baguettes and local produce await along the cobbled lanes. Just five minutes by car, the historic town of Pézenas reveals a lively blend of art, culture and cuisine, with its Saturday morning market and antique shops drawing visitors from far and wide. For beach days, the Mediterranean is just 20 minutes away, offering family-friendly shores, watersports and seafront restaurants.

Whether you're sipping local wine beside the pool, browsing market stalls in Pézenas or discovering the wild beauty of the Languedoc, Maison L'Évêque is perfectly placed to make every day feel effortlessly special.

Location & Local Information

In a residential area in the village of Nézignan-l'Évêque, Maison L'Évêque is just a short stroll from the heart of village life and less than half an hour from the sandy shores of the Mediterranean.

On the corner of a road leading to the village, in just five minutes on foot you'll reach the village's café bar, a hotel restaurant, a bakery, a grocery store and local butcher. The village itself is steeped in character, with honey-hued stone houses, winding lanes and a warm, local atmosphere that invites you to slow down and savour the rhythm of rural living.

Just 5km north lies the exquisite town of Pézenas, a historic gem famed for its cobbled streets, lovely shops and lively Saturday market. Once the adopted home of playwright Molière, Pézenas is now celebrated for its antique shops and cultural scene, offering a rich calendar of summer festivals and open-air concerts. Dining is a true pleasure here, with a wide array of restaurants and cafés nestled into the old town's medieval alleyways, making every meal feel like a special occasion.

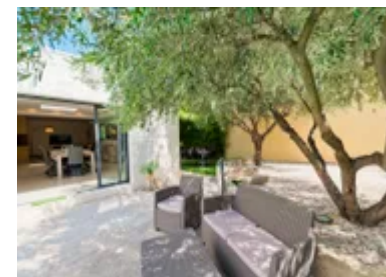
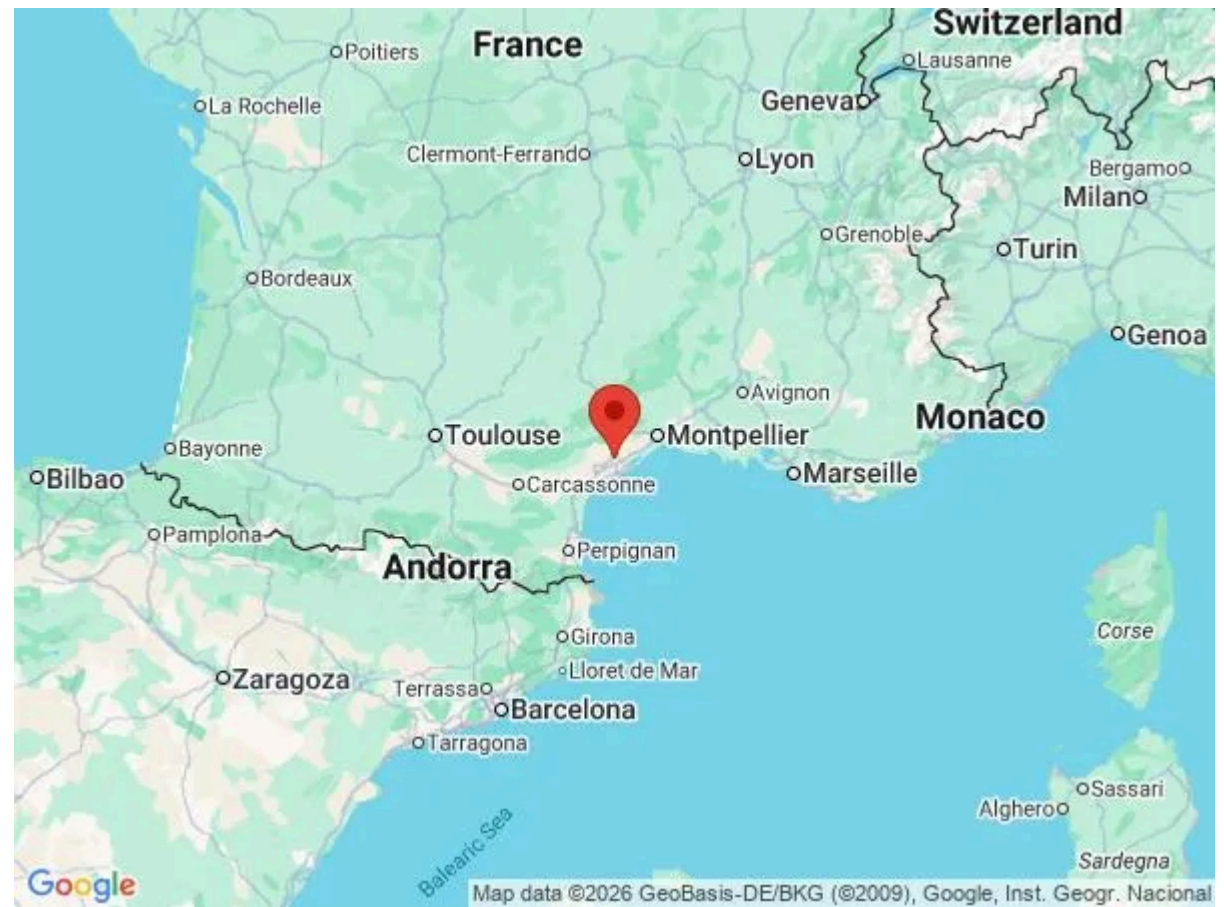
The surrounding countryside is a patchwork of vineyards and wine domaines, many of which welcome visitors for tastings and tours. The Languedoc region is one of France's most dynamic wine areas, producing everything from crisp Picpoul de Pinet to full-bodied reds from nearby appellations. Meandering through the villages that dot the landscape, wine lovers will find themselves spoiled for choice, with opportunities to meet passionate vintners and discover hidden gems.

For those craving the sea, the Mediterranean coastline is within easy reach - just a 20 to 30-minute drive brings you to the sandy shores of Cap d'Agde (18km), Plage Sérignan (28km) and Vias Plage (17km). Across the coastline, families can enjoy bustling beach clubs and a wealth of watersports, while food lovers can sample freshly harvested oysters from the Étang de Thau, best enjoyed with a glass of chilled local white in Marseillan (15km).

Whether you're exploring the historic towns, relaxing in vineyard-dotted countryside or soaking up the sun on the coast, Maison L'Évêque offers the perfect base from which to enjoy the rich and varied delights of this stunning corner of southern France.
